5 min	Whole group	The pupils understand the meaning of "das Public Viewing".	Play the video once and ask the pupils if they know what "das Public Viewing" means. 			Ask them if they have attended any live open-air screenings in the past.	Ball bleiben: Kicking Dreams"  Interactive whiteboard/screen	Wart ihr schon mal bei einem Public Viewing?  – Have you ever been to a public viewing?
8 min	In pairs	The pupils can understand key football activities.	Tell the pupils that they are going to work in pairs to find key football activities in a puzzle and highlight them.  The activities are verbs and refer to what footballers, referees and coaches do on the pitch.  Show the pupils that they can find the translations of the words under the puzzle, if they need help. 5 min	In pairs	The pupils can understand personal information about a football player.	Tell the pupils that they are going to continue working in pairs.  Now they are going to watch a video about a German football player and answer questions about her during the video.	German starter course on the Gimagine Award platform: The fifth stage "Sofia Kleinherne: Fußballerin" of step 3 in module 12 "Am Ball bleiben: Kicking Dreams"  A digital tablet or computer for each pair	Wir arbeiten in Paaren. – Let's work in pairs.  Wir sehen ein Video über eine deutsche Fußballspielerin. – Let's watch a video about a female German football player.  Wir beantworten Fragen. – Let's answer the questions.
10 min	In small groups	The pupils can create posters with detailed information about football players.	Tell the pupils that they are going to work in small groups.  They are going to create a poster about one or two famous football players from different countries.  They can use the internet to find correct information about the players.	<ul> <li>One piece of paper for each pair</li> <li>Coloured pens/pencils</li> <li>A digital tablet or computer for each pair</li> </ul>	Wir arbeiten in kleinen Gruppen. – Let's work in small groups. 			Use the whiteboard to demonstrate the information the posters must include, as follows:  • Der Spieler/die Spielerin heißt XXX. – The player is called XXX  • Er/sie kommt aus XXX. – He/she comes from XXX.  • Er/sie ist XXX Jahre alt. – He/she is XXX years old.  • Er/Sie spielt für XXX. – He/she plays for XXX.  • Das kann er/sie gut: XXX. – This is what he/she is good at: XXX  Tell the pupils that they can add extra information too, and can use coloured pens/pencils to decorate their posters. 10 min	Whole group	The pupils can present information about a football player in German.	Tell the pupils that they are going to present their posters now.  Do an example for the pupils first.		Wir präsentieren unsere Posters. – Let's present our posters!  Ein Beispiel. – One example.
2 min	In pairs	The pupils can say goodbye in German.	Recap what the pupils have achieved in the session, focussing on the key learning points.  You could throw a ball or small object to pupils, asking them key questions from the session and see if they can answer them in German without using their notes.  Congratulate all pupils on their work and then dismiss them in German.	Interactive whiteboard/screen     A ball or a small object (pen, ruler)	Wir haben viel gelernt. – We've learnt a lot!  Toll gemacht. – Well done!  Tschüss. – Bye.  Auf wiedersehen. – Goodbye.
