- Have all your material laid out and ready to use
- Think of engaging gestures, routines and rituals to build a sense of togetherness and to aid repetition of vocabulary
- Keep it positive model correct use of language, instead of correcting mistakes
- Have fun and incorporate play and movement as much as possible
- Go on a language discovery journey with the children - display curiosity

To be able to talk about breakfast food preferences.

2 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Hello" song	Sing Felix and Franzi out of the letterbox, with the music. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/halo_felix_mastered.mp3	<ul> <li>Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio</li> <li>Felix and Franzi letterbox</li> <li>Felix and Franzi puppets</li> </ul>	Hallo Felix, Hallo Franzi! - Hello Felix, hello Franzi!  Guten Morgen - Good morning  Guten Tag - Good day  Wave to greet the puppets and clap to the song. End the song with a wave and a big "Hallo".
1 min	Whole group	The children can identify new vocabulary	Ask Franzi "Wie geht's?" ("How are you?")  She replies with "Es geht. Ich habe Hunger und ich habe Durst". ("I'm ok. I am hungry and I am thirsty.")  Suggest they watch the video to find out what Felix and Franzi eat for breakfast.	Felix and Franzi puppets	Wie geht's, Franzi? - How are you, Franzi?  Es geht. Ich habe Hunger und ich habe Durst I'm ok. I am hungry and I am thirsty.  Was isst du und trinkst du zum Frühstück? - What do you eat and drink for breakfast? 10 min	Whole group	The children can correctly pronounce new vocabulary	Watch Felix & Franzi #7: "Time for breakfast" in full here: https://youtu.be/S4OQfWZZreM?list=PL5jjjxhBmRrmtlRKYGJZgHGn PQmbePPQ  Watch a second time and pause after each food and drink item to practise the pronunciation. 			You should also pause at 0:22 to discuss what food the learners can see on Felix's tray. Cheese? Bread? Eggs? Rolls? Sliced meat? The leader explains to the learners that a German breakfast is different from a British breakfast.		Er isst den Käse, das Brot, das Ei, das Brötchen und die Wurst.  – He is eatring cheese, bread, egg, bread roll and sausage.  Wiederholen bitte Please repeat.
5 min	In pairs	The children know new vocabulary related to food and drinks	The children play a memory game by matching picture and word cards.	Food flashcards	Wir spielen Memory. Let's play a memory game.
5 min	Whole group/	The children can say what they like to eat for breakfast	Ask Felix "Was isst du gern zum Frühstück?" ("What do you like eating for breakfast?")  Felix picks up a flashcard of some bread and answers "Ich esse gern Brot." ("I like eating bread.")  Felix picks up a flashcard of some sausage and says "Ich esse nicht gern Wurst." ("I don't like eating sausage.")  Use the board to write up the key language, as follows:  Was isst du gern zum Frühstück?  Ich esse gern XXX.  Ich esse nicht gern XXX.  Ask one or two learners to say what they like eating for breakfast. They could also add what they do not like eating.  Ask the learners to work in pairs to ask each other what they like to eat for breakfast by using the flashcards. 5 min Pair wor	ork what t	nildren can say they like to at breakfast	The leader tells the learners that they will now work in pairs to say what they like and don't like drinking at breakfast.  Ask Franzi "Was trinkst du gern zum Frühstück?" ("What do you like drinking for breakfast?")  Franzi picks up a flashcard of the juice and answers "Ich trinke gern Saft." ("I like drinking juice.")  Franzi picks up a flashcard of the milk and says "Ich trinke nicht gern Milch." ("I don't like drinking milk.")  Use the board to write up the key language, as follows:  Was trinkst du gern zum Frühstück?  Ich trinke gern XXX.  Ich trinke nicht gern XXX.  Do an example with the learners before they begin working in pairs.	Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio     Felix and Franzi puppets     Food flashcards	Wir arbeiten in Paaren. – Let's work in pairs.  Was trinkst du gern zum Frühstück, Franzi? - What do you like drinking for breakfast, Franzi?  Ich trinke gern Saft I like drinking juice. (Doing a thumbs up or rubbing his stomach.) 2 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Goodbye" song	Sing Felix and Franzi back into the box. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/goodbye_fel_ix_mastered.mp3	Interactive     whiteboard/screen     with internet     access and audio     Felix and Franzi     letterbox     Felix and Franzi     puppets	Tschüss Felix, Tschüss Franzi - Bye Felix, bye Franzi  Tschüss Freunde - Bye friends  Auf Wiedersehen - Goodbye  Bis bald - See you soon  Incorporate a goodbye wave. You can also think of a ritual for putting the puppets back into the box, like a "shushing" sound to signal that Felix and Franzi are going back to sleep.
