2 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Hello" song	Sing Felix and Franzi out of the letterbox, with the music. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/halo_felix_mastered.mp3	 Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi letterbox Felix and Franzi puppets 	Hallo Felix, Hallo Franzi! - Hello Felix, hello Franzi! Guten Morgen - Good morning Guten Tag - Good day Wave to greet the puppets and clap to the song. End the song with a wave and a big "Hallo".
3 min	Whole group	The children can recall breakfast food and preferences vocabulary	The leader revises the breakfast food and preferences vocabulary with the learners. Felix and Franzi ask the learners what they like eating and what they like drinking. If desired, you can use the board to write up the key language, as follows: • Was isst du gern zum Frühstück? • Ich esse gern XXX. • Was trinkst du gern zum Frühstück? • Ich trinke gern XXX. – I like drinking XXX. Encourage the learners to reply in full sentences, and model correct pronunciation with the class as necessary.	Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi puppets	Was isst du gern zum Frühstück? – What do you like eating for breakfast? Ich esse gern XXX. – I like eating XXX. Was trinkst du gern zum Frühstück? – What do you like drinking for breakfast? Ich trinke gern XXX. – I like drinking XXX. Wir wiederholen. – Let's repeat.
3 min	Whole group	The children can identify new vocabulary	Watch "Deutsch mit Socke- Eine Pausenbrot für Socke" in full here: https://www.planet-schule.de/schwerpunkt/deutsch-mit-socke/ein-pausenbrot-fuer-socke-film-100.html Ask the learners what Socke wanted on his sandwich.	Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio	Sind alle bereit? - Is everyone ready? Ja! - Yes!

			Can they also work out how he said "I don't like XXX"?		Zuhören bitte Listen carefully. Wir schauen ein Video! - Let's watch a video! Was isst Socke gern? - What does Socke like to eat? Er isst gern Brot mit Schokolade! - He likes to eat bread with chocolate! Er mag keinen Käse He doesn't like cheese. Er mag keinen Salat He doesn't like salad. Er mag keine Salami He doesn't like salami.
5 min	Paired work	The children can say what they like / don't like for a breaktime snack	Ask Felix "Was magst du?" ("What do you like?") Felix picks up a flashcard of some bread and answers "Ich mag Brot." ("I like bread.") Next, ask Franzi "Was magst du nicht?" ("What do you not like?") Franzi picks up a flashcard of the sausage and answers "Ich mag keine Wurst." ("I don't like sausage.") Use the board to write up the key language, as follows: Was magst du?	 Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi puppets Food flashcards 	Was magst du Felix? – What do you like, Felix? Ich mag Brot I like bread. Was magst du nicht, Franzi? – What do you not like, Franzi? Ich mag keine Wurst. – I don't like sausage. Wir arbeiten in Paaren. – Let's work in pairs.

			 Ich mag XXX. Was magst du nicht? Ich mag kein / keine / keinen XXX. Do an example with one of the learners before they begin working in pairs using the flashcards. Note It is not a major error if the learners use the incorrect version of kein / keine / keinen, so use your discretion about the need to correct this language.		Ein Beispiel. – One example.
10 min	Whole group	The children can join in with a song and understand idiomatic language	Tell the learners that they are going to join in with the song "Wir haben Hunger" here: https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/u-7.1 wirhabenhunger.mp3 If desired, the learners can use the lyrics sheet. Note You can explain to the learners that this is a fun song, which might be sung at a party, in a club or on a holiday camp, but not normally at home or in school! 5 min	Paired work	The children can say if they are hungry or	Ask Felix "Hast du Hunger?" ("Are you hungry?")	Interactive whiteboard/screen	Wir arbeiten in Paaren. – Let's work in pairs.

		thirsty, and what they would like to eat	Felix answers "Ja, ich habe Hunger. Ich möchte Käse." ("Yes, I am hungry. I would like cheese.") Next, ask Franzi "Hast du Durst?" ("Are you thirsty?") Franzi answers "Ja, ich habe Durst. Ich möchte Wasser." ("Yes, I am thirsty. I would like water.") Use the board to write up the key language, as follows: Hast du Hunger? Hast du Durst? Ja, ich habe Hunger/Durst. Ich möchte XXX. Do an example with one of the learners before they begin working in pairs.	with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi puppets	Hast du Hunger, Felix? – Are you hungry, Felix? Ja, ich habe Hunger. Ich möchte Käse Yes, I am hungry. I would like cheese. Hast du Durst, Franzi? - Are you thirsty, Franzi? Ja, ich habe Durst. Ich möchte Wasser Yes, I am thirsty. I would like water. 2 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Goodbye" song	Sing Felix and Franzi back into the box. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/goodbye_fel ix_mastered.mp3	 Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi letterbox Felix and Franzi puppets 	Tschüss Felix, Tschüss Franzi - Bye Felix, bye Franzi Tschüss Freunde - Bye friends Auf Wiedersehen - Goodbye Bis bald - See you soon Incorporate a goodbye wave. You can also think of a ritual for putting the puppets back into the box, like a "shushing" sound to signal that Felix and Franzi are going back to sleep.
