- (optional) lightweight item to pass around a circle

- (optional) large parachute designed for group activities

15min	Whole class	The children can use greetings in German and engage in short dialogues.	 Practise the greetings and phrases learned so far: Passing a bean bag/ ball/ inflatable globe/ other useful item around a circle and saying a greeting or introducing yourself when the item reaches you. Learners stand in two circles, one inside the other, with learners in the inner circle facing outwards towards a partner in the outer circle. When the music starts, the two circles move in opposite directions. When the music stops, greet the new person you are facing, in German. Playing the greetings song and the learners move around the space. When the music stops, shake hands with the people nearest you and greet them. Same activity as above but use individual puppets from lesson 1#2 to greet each other instead. Use a 'parachute'- each learner is given a greeting (Hallo, Guten Morgen, Guten Tag, Guten Abend) and holds the edge of the parachute. Leader calls out one of the greetings while the group lifts the parachute up (still 	 Lightweight item to pass around a circle (optional). Individual puppets - see lesson 1#2 (optional). 			 holding the edges). As the parachute descends, slowly, the learners with the relevant greeting have to run underneath to a different space, chanting their greeting at the same time. All the above games can also be played with the goodbye words as well. 		
5min	Whole class	The children understand important facts about the geography of Germany.	Explore the regions of Germany- what do you think Germany looks like? Does it have mountains, beaches, jungles, forests, lakes cities or castles? https://ukgermanconnection.org/kids/find-out-en/regions-of-germany/	Interactive whiteboard	Use gestures to describe mountains, rivers, trees or buildings.
2mins	Whole class	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi goodbye song.	Sing Felix and Franzi back into the box: https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/ goodbye_felix_mastered.mp3		Auf Wiedersehen, Felix, auf Wiedersehen Franzi! - Goodbye Felix, goodbye Franzi! (Incorporate a goodbye wave. You can also think of a ritual for putting the puppets back into the box like a shushing sound to signal that Felix and Franzi are going back to sleep.)
