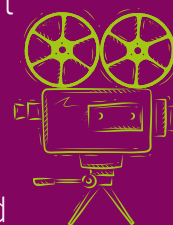


OPEN CALL FOR ARTISTIC PROJECTS

After the huge success of our Open Call for artistic projects last year, we are announcing it to go into a third round for 2025!

The concept stays the same: We want to give both established and emerging local artist the chance to work on their project with us during this year. That includes artistic initiatives with all forms of art: music, contemporary dance, photography, film, theater, visual arts and many more.



Through this call for applications, we seek to support innovative artistic and cultural initiatives in Rwanda. Artists from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply with concrete project proposals. If selected, we will provide a platform to showcase the work.

Who can apply?

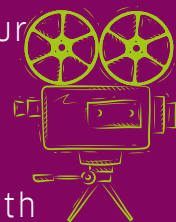
All artists based in Rwanda that have an innovative project idea. Grantees of 2023 or 2024 are not eligible to apply.

Does my project proposal have a chance?

All projects that meet the requirements will be considered. However, we will only be able to fund a limited number of projects. Innovative and especially creative and new ideas will be favoured. Thank you for understanding.

I did not receive the grant last year. Can I apply with the same project again?

Yes, that is possible. If you have improved your proposal and think it fits our criteria, feel free to hand it in again.



How can I apply?

You can apply by sending us your concrete, elaborated proposal together with the required documents until the 14th of April to assistant-kigali@goethe.de. Please attach all documents as PDFs to one e-Mail and hand it in only once!

What application documents are required?

- The filled out application form (to be downloaded on our website)
- Budget plan (please only use the template available on our website)
- CV of the project leader
- Further reference material (links, photographs, video material of work, ...)

Until when can I apply?

The application deadline is Monday, April 14th 2025, 23:59pm GMT+2.



What happens after the application?

All applicants will receive a written confirmation or rejection within three months after the deadline. If you receive a confirmation, we will schedule a meeting to discuss the potential of our cooperation and your project. If you are chosen as a grant recipient, we will set up a contract to legally determine our collaboration.

The implementation of the chosen projects will take place between July and December 2025.
