**Lesson 10 (35 min)** 

## **Objective**

To be able to give personal information in a memory book.

6 min	Whole group	Students can recall how to ask how someone is feeling and what his or her favourite (animal, colour, food, hobby) is.	The teacher starts the lesson asking the children which day it is today (slide 1).  Using slide 2, the teacher then explains that they are going to play a "walk and freeze" game to review some questions and answers learned in previous lessons.  The teacher revises the language using the example dialogues on slides 2-7.  The children walk or dance around the classroom to some German music. When the music stops the teacher asks the children to find a partner and start the conversation as in slide 3. The teacher plays the music again. When the music stops, the children start the conversation as in slide 4. The game continues until the last conversation as presented in slide 7. 5 min	Whole group/ in pairs	Students know the end of the story and can name the 7 objects Wuschel is taking home.	The teacher explains that Wuschel is flying back home and that their lessons are coming to an end (slide 8).  The teacher tells the children that they are going to read/listen to the end of the story to find out which last object Wuschel is getting today (slide 9-10).  The teacher then asks the children to complete task 1 on page 89 in pairs. Once the children have finished, each pair is asked to name an object and the teacher circles it in red on the board. 5 min	Whole group	The children can say what they like.	The teacher asks the children to open their books to pages 92-93 and complete task 3.  Once the children have finished, they ask each other the question "Was magst du?" and answer "Ich mag und und". They do this by throwing a ball around the classroom.  Optional: If time, the teacher then asks the children to open their books to pages 94-95 and complete tasks 4 and 5. The children compare their answers with the answers in the answer booklet. The teacher explains that the children will revise the learning content from previous club lessons by working in teams at different learning stations. 			Refore the lesson, the teacher must read the station instructions for teachers. This provides details of how each activity works and also gives instructions about what materials are required at each station. For example, crayons for the colours activity. Please also note that the 12 minutes allocated requires each station to be completed in 4 minutes. You should also circulate to support the children and answer any questions, and also encourage them to work as a team. If the children need more time at each station, you can let them e.g. only do one worksheet/task at each station or only two stations in class and hand out the other worksheets for homework.
