Theme 9 - Session 1 (of 3)

Tipps and Tricks for your Club Session

- Hang up the washing line ready to hang clothes.
- Go over pronunciation help
- Have all your material laid out and ready to use
- Think of engaging gestures, routines and rituals to build a sense of togetherness and to aid repetition of vocabulary
- Keep it positive model correct use of language, instead of correcting mistakes
- Have fun and incorporate play and movement as much as possible
- Go on a language discovery journey with the children - display curiosity

- Domino Clothes
- Lyrics Sheet

| 2 min | Whole group | The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Hello" song | Sing Felix and Franzi out of the letterbox, with the music. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/halo_felix mastered.mp3 Felix and Franzi should be wearing assorted items of clothing and carrying more. | • | Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi letterbox Felix and Franzi puppets A selection of clothes that will fit the Felix and Franzi puppets | Hallo Felix, Hallo Franzi! - Hello Felix, hello Franzi! Guten Morgen - Good morning Guten Tag - Good day Wave to greet the puppets and clap to the song. End the song with a wave and a big "Hallo". |

| 1 min | Whole group | The children can identify new vocabulary | Ask Felix "Wie geht's?" ("How are you?") He replies with "Kaputt!" ("Broken!") and looks sad. Franzi is comforting him. Encourage the learners to wonder what might be wrong with Felix. Suggest watching the video to find out. | Felix and Franzi puppets A selection of clothes that will fit the Felix and Franzi puppets | Wie geht's, Felix? - How are you, Felix? Kaputt! - Broken! Was ist los, Felix? - What's wrong, Felix? Wir schauen ein Video! - Let's watch a video! |
| 5 min | Whole group | The children can repeat new vocabulary | Watch Felix und Franzi #6: "The broken washing machine" in full here: https://youtu.be/PSvrlu_Mkzc?list=PL5jjjxhBmRrmtlRKY GJZqHGn_PQmbePPQ You should pause at 0:43 to discuss what "kaputt" means. Explain to the learners that the washing machine is broken so Felix and Franzi are going to have to handwash all their clothes! | Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio | Sind alle bereit? - Is everyone ready? | 10 min | Whole group | The children can pronounce the clothing vocabulary correctly | The leader gets the children ready to help with the washing. They sit in a circle on the floor; they pull their sleeves back, etc. Together with Felix and Franzi the leader takes one piece of clothing out of basket, holds it up and introduces the German word, children repeat. Now all pretend to wash it while singing: Wir waschen, wir waschen, wir waschen den ganzen Tag. Wir waschen, wir waschen, wir waschen den ganzen Tag. (We are washing all day long.) The leader hangs up the piece of clothing on the washing line and keeps asking: Was ist das? The children say the word. Once all pieces of clothing are on the washing line, you take one piece of clothing off the line while the children have their eyes closed. They guess what is missing. Repeat. Now all the washing has dried. The children sing with you: Wir bügeln, wir bügeln, wir bügeln den ganzen Tag. (We are ironing all day long.) Note Make sure you emphasise the "Das sind die Schuhe" ("Those are the shoes") and "Das sind die Socken" | Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio A selection of clothes that will fit the Felix and Franzi puppets Washing basket or bag for the clothing Washing line and pegs for the clothing Lyrics sheet | Zuhören bitte Listen carefully. | 5 min | Paired work | The children can recall the clothing vocabulary correctly | The leader asks the children to play the memory and/or domino game to practice the new vocabulary. | Memory clothesDomino clothes | Wir spielen. – Let's play a game. |
| 5 min | Whole group | The children can recall and pronounce the clothing vocabulary correctly | The leader tells the children that they are going to play the game "Ich packe meinen Koffer und nehme mit" The leader asks the children which clothes they would pack in their suitcase and explains the game: The first child says: Ich packe meinen Koffer und nehme (add a piece of clothes in German) mit. The next child repeats that and adds another piece of clothes. Example: Child 1: Ich packe meinen Koffer und nehme die Hose mit. Child 2: Ich packe meinen Koffer und nehme die Hose und das Kleid mit. Child 3: Ich packe meinen Koffer und nehme die Hose, das Kleid und den Pullover mit. Note: The children will most probably say "der Pullover".
