Theme 9 - Session 3 (of 3)

Tipps and Tricks for your Club Session

- Watch the video with instructions for making the three-cornered hat before the lesson.
- Make a small hat for both Felix und Franzi.
- Listen to the "mein Hut" song to learn it.
- Familiarise yourself with the new vocabulary
- Go over pronunciation help
- Have all your material laid out and ready to use
- Think of engaging gestures, routines and rituals to build a sense of togetherness and to aid repetition of vocabulary
- Keep it positive model correct use of language, instead of correcting mistakes
- Have fun and incorporate play and movement as much as possible
- Go on a language discovery journey with the children - display curiosity

Objective

To be able to make a three-cornered hat and sing a song about it.

Materials

- Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio
- Felix and Franzi letterbox
- Felix and Franzi puppets
- Three-cornered hats for Felix and Franzi
- Sheets of A4 or A3 paper or newspaper per learner, depending on the desired size of hats. (A4 will fit a puppet. A large sheet of newspaper should fit a child.)
- Colour pens/pencils/crayons
- Materials to decorate like glitter or feathers etc.
- Glue sticks
- Lyrics Sheet

3 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Hello" song	Sing Felix and Franzi out of the letterbox, with the music. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/halo_felix_mastered.mp3 Felix and Franzi should both be wearing a paper, three-cornered hat.	 Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi letterbox Felix and Franzi puppets Three-cornered hats for Felix and Franzi 	Hallo Felix, Hallo Franzi! - Hello Felix, hello Franzi! Guten Morgen - Good morning Guten Tag - Good day Wave to greet the puppets and clap to the song. End the song with a wave and a big "Hallo".









Social Form	Learning Objective	Content	Materials	Phrases and Gestures
Whole group	The children can sing along with a song in German	The learners look at the hats that Felix and Franzi are wearing. The leader draws attention to the fact that the hats have three corners, and explains that there is a traditional German song about this hat. Listen to the song "Mein Hut" here: goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/mein hut mastered.mp3 As support, give the learners the lyrics sheet. First, listen to the whole song. Then, repeat the words line by line so that everyone can practise the pronunciation. Finally, sing the whole song together.	Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio	Was tragen Felix und Franzi? – What are Felix und Franzi wearing? Felix und Franzi tragen beide einen Hut. – Felix and Franzi are both wearing a hat. Der Hut hat drei Ecken. – The hat has 3 corners. Es gibt ein bekanntes deutsches Lied. – There is a famous German song. Das Lied heißt "Mein Hut". – The song is called "My hat". Zuhören bitte. – Listen carefully. Wiederholen bitte. – Please repeat. Wir singen. – Let's sing.

15 min	Whole group	The children can make their own paper hats	The leader explains that the learners are now going to make their own three-cornered hat. The leader can either show the YouTube video or they could do their own demonstration for how to make the hat: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DTtNey6n]zk If using the video, pause to ensure that the learners have time to follow each step. The learners can then decorate their hats, present and describe the colours and sing the song again. If additional time, the children could also make a display where they paint different pieces of clothes and label them with the German words. Note It would be good for the learners to hear the German instructions, even though they will not be expected to understand everything.	 Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Sheets of A4 or A3 paper or newspaper per learner, depending on the desired size of hats. (A4 will fit a puppet. A large sheet of newspaper should fit a child.) 2 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Goodbye" song	Sing Felix and Franzi back into the box. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/goodbye_felix_mastered.mp3	Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio	Tschüss Felix, Tschüss Franzi - Bye Felix, bye Franzi Tschüss Freunde - Bye friends Auf Wiedersehen - Goodbye Bis bald - See you soon Incorporate a goodbye wave. You can also think of a ritual for putting the puppets back into the box, like a "shushing" sound
