Theme 9 - Session 3 (of 3)

Tipps and Tricks for your Club Session

- Watch the video with instructions for making the three-cornered hat before the lesson.
- Make a small hat for both Felix und Franzi.
- Listen to the "mein Hut" song to learn it.
- Familiarise yourself with the new vocabulary
- Go over pronunciation help
- Have all your material laid out and ready to use
- Think of engaging gestures, routines and rituals to build a sense of togetherness and to aid repetition of vocabulary
- Keep it positive - model correct use of language, instead of correcting mistakes
- Have fun and incorporate play and movement as much as possible
- Go on a language discovery journey with the children - display curiosity

Objective

To be able to make a three-cornered hat and sing a song about it.

Materials

- Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio
- Felix and Franzi letterbox
- Felix and Franzi puppets
- Three-cornered hats for Felix and Franzi
- Sheets of A4 or A3 paper or newspaper per learner, depending on the desired size of hats. (A4 will fit a puppet. A large sheet of newspaper should fit a child.)
- Colour pens/pencils/crayons
- Materials to decorate like glitter or feathers etc.
- Glue sticks
- Lyrics Sheet

3 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Hello" song	<p>Sing Felix and Franzi out of the letterbox, with the music. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/halo_felix_mastered.mp3</p> <p>Felix and Franzi should both be wearing a paper, three-cornered hat.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio • Felix and Franzi letterbox • Felix and Franzi puppets • Three-cornered hats for Felix and Franzi 	<p>Hallo Felix, Hallo Franzi! - Hello Felix, hello Franzi!</p> <p>Guten Morgen - Good morning</p> <p>Guten Tag - Good day</p> <p>Wave to greet the puppets and clap to the song. End the song with a wave and a big "Hallo".</p>

10 min	Whole group	The children can sing along with a song in German	<p>The learners look at the hats that Felix and Franzi are wearing.</p> <p>The leader draws attention to the fact that the hats have three corners, and explains that there is a traditional German song about this hat.</p> <p>Listen to the song "Mein Hut" here: goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/mein_hut_mastered.mp3 As support, give the learners the lyrics sheet.</p> <p>First, listen to the whole song. Then, repeat the words line by line so that everyone can practise the pronunciation. Finally, sing the whole song together.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio 	<p>Was tragen Felix und Franzi? – What are Felix und Franzi wearing?</p> <p>Felix und Franzi tragen beide einen Hut. – Felix and Franzi are both wearing a hat.</p> <p>Der Hut hat drei Ecken. – The hat has 3 corners.</p> <p>Es gibt ein bekanntes deutsches Lied. – There is a famous German song.</p> <p>Das Lied heißt "Mein Hut". – The song is called "My hat".</p> <p>Zuhören bitte. - Listen carefully.</p> <p>Wiederholen bitte. - Please repeat.</p> <p>Wir singen. – Let's sing.</p>

15 min	Whole group	The children can make their own paper hats	<p>The leader explains that the learners are now going to make their own three-cornered hat.</p> <p>The leader can either show the YouTube video or they could do their own demonstration for how to make the hat: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DTtNey6nJzk</p> <p>If using the video, pause to ensure that the learners have time to follow each step.</p> <p>The learners can then decorate their hats, present and describe the colours and sing the song again.</p> <p>If additional time, the children could also make a display where they paint different pieces of clothes and label them with the German words.</p> <p>Note It would be good for the learners to hear the German instructions, even though they will not be expected to understand everything.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Sheets of A4 or A3 paper or newspaper per learner, depending on the desired size of hats. 2 min	Whole group	The children can join in with the Felix and Franzi "Goodbye" song	<p>Sing Felix and Franzi back into the box. https://www.goethe.de/resources/files/mp31/goodbye_felix_mastered.mp3</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio 	<p>Tschüss Felix, Tschüss Franzi - Bye Felix, bye Franzi</p> <p>Tschüss Freunde - Bye friends</p> <p>Auf Wiedersehen - Goodbye</p> <p>Bis bald - See you soon</p> <p>Incorporate a goodbye wave. You can also think of a ritual for putting the puppets back into the box, like a "shushing" sound</p>
