

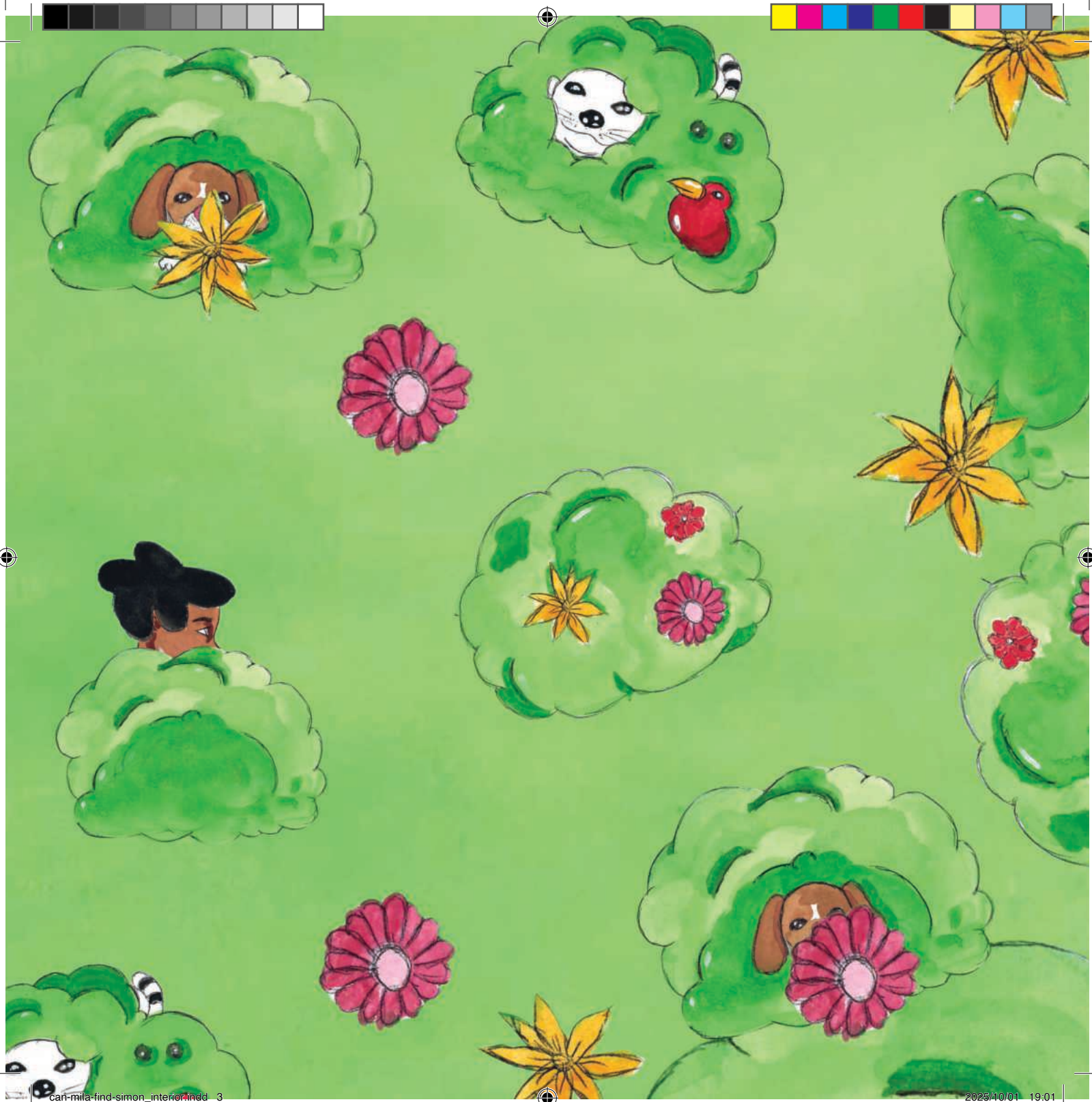

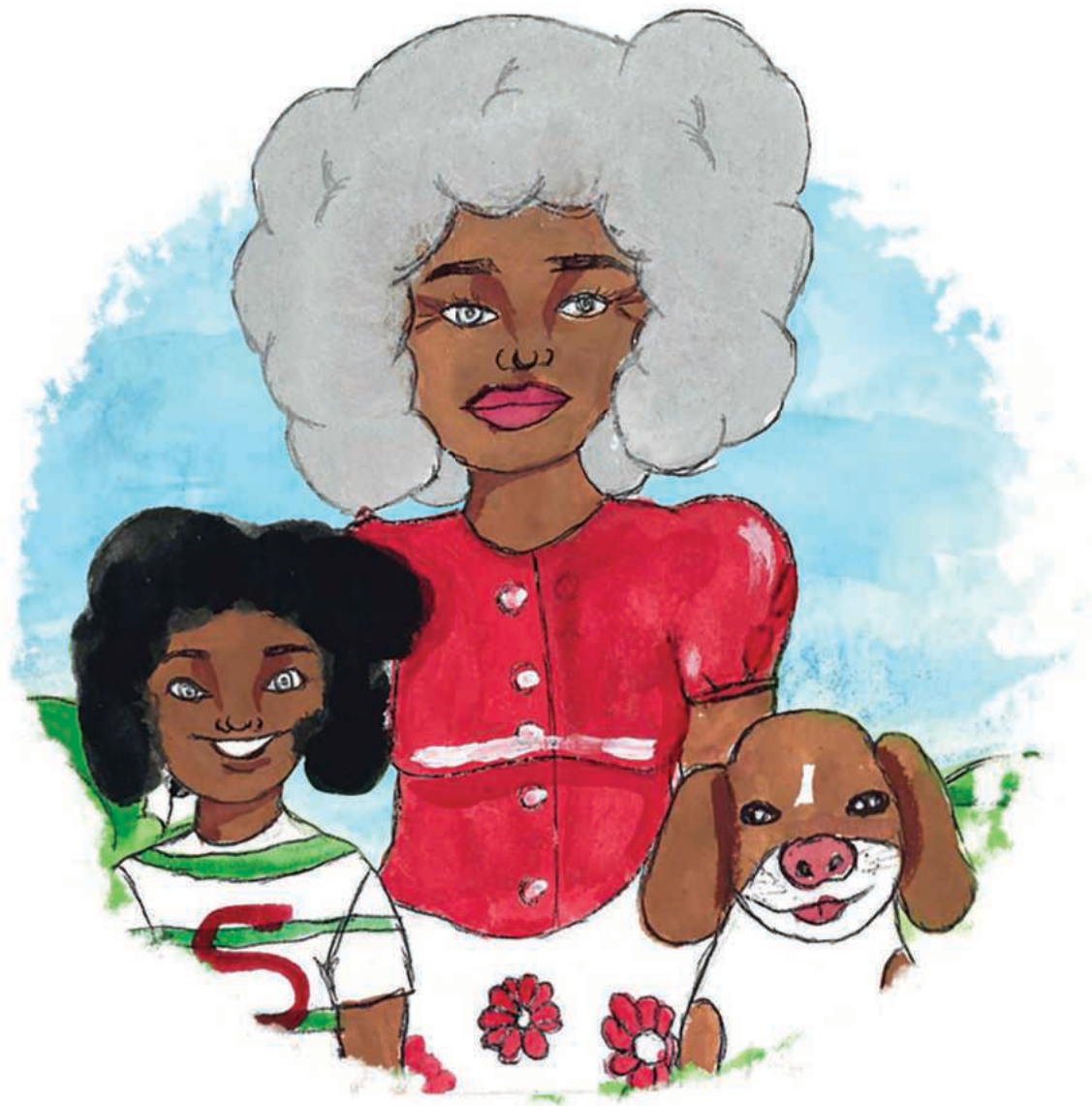

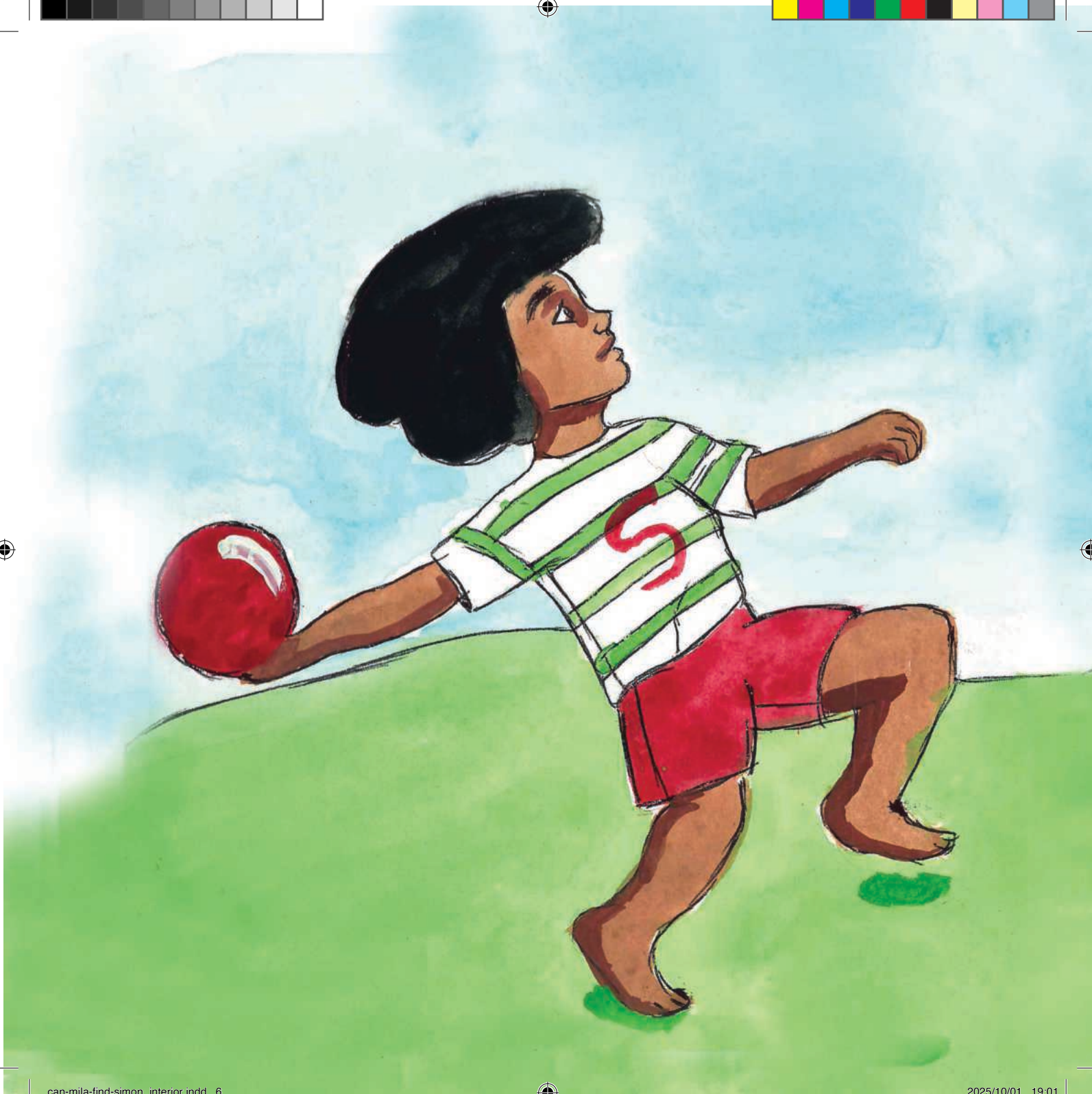

Where did she go?



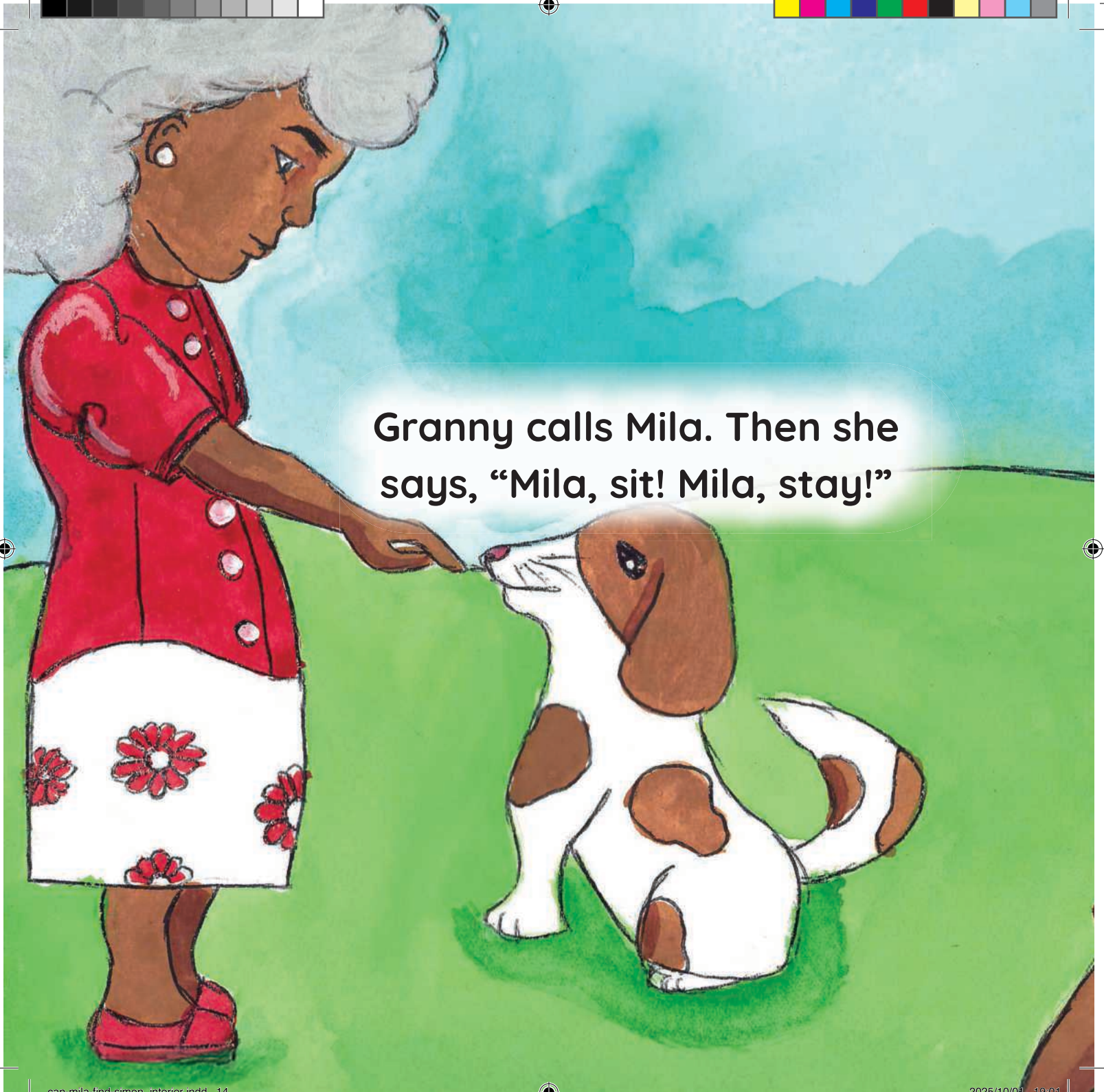


Hiding behind the ...car!

Now I will hide!”

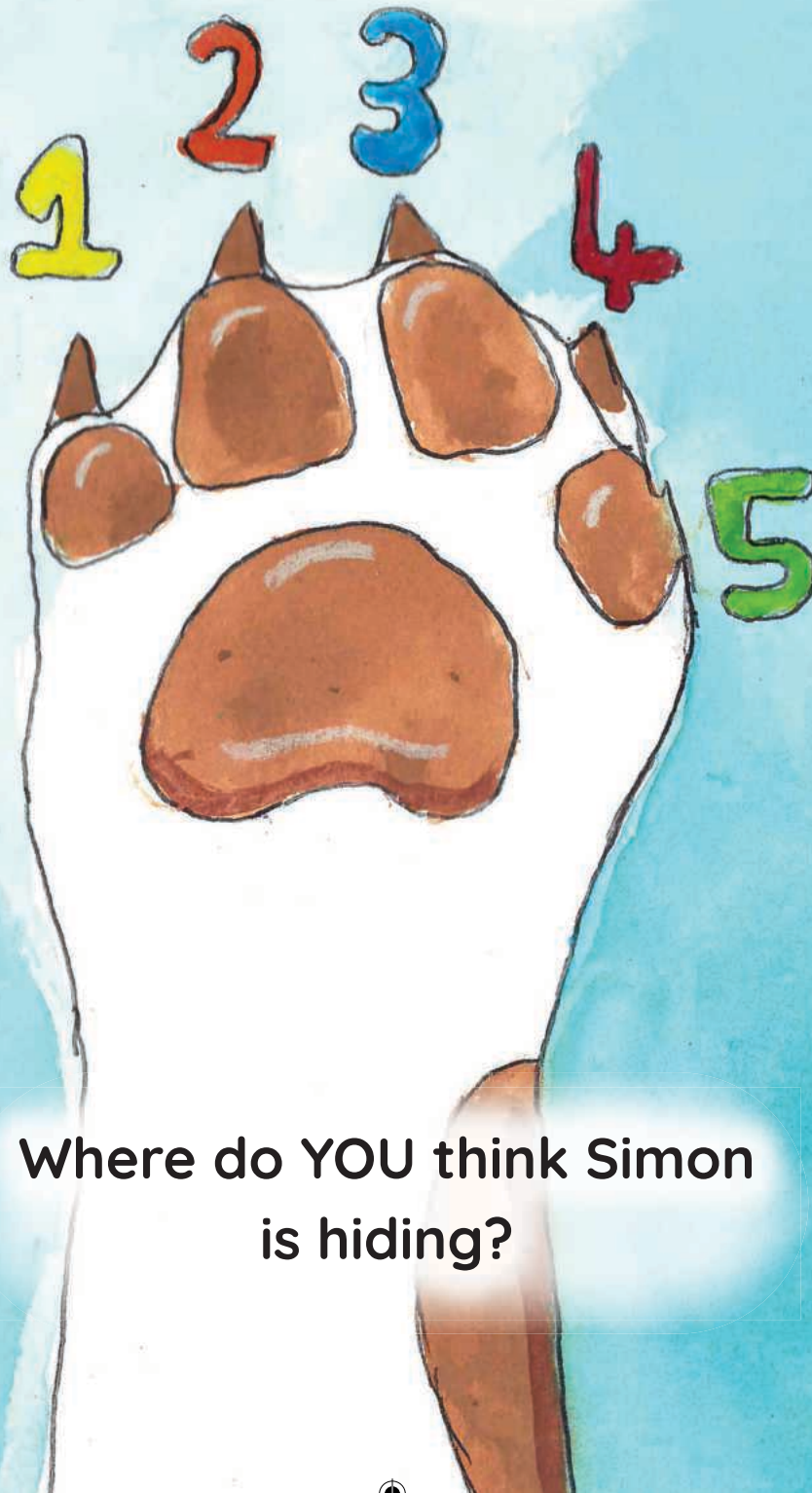




Granny counts.

is hiding?



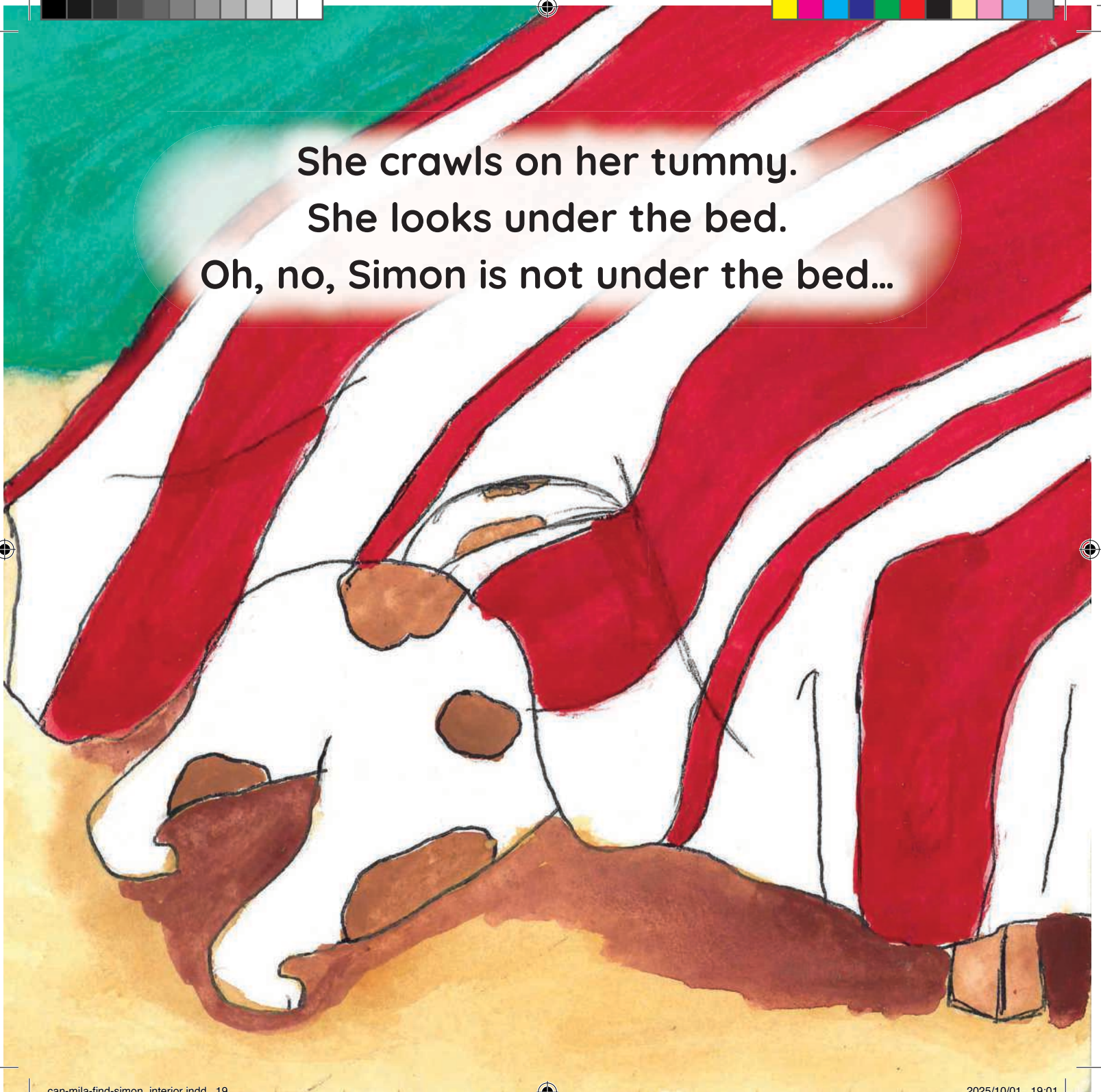


Simon squeaks: “Mi, Mi!”

Oh, no, Simon is not under the bed...





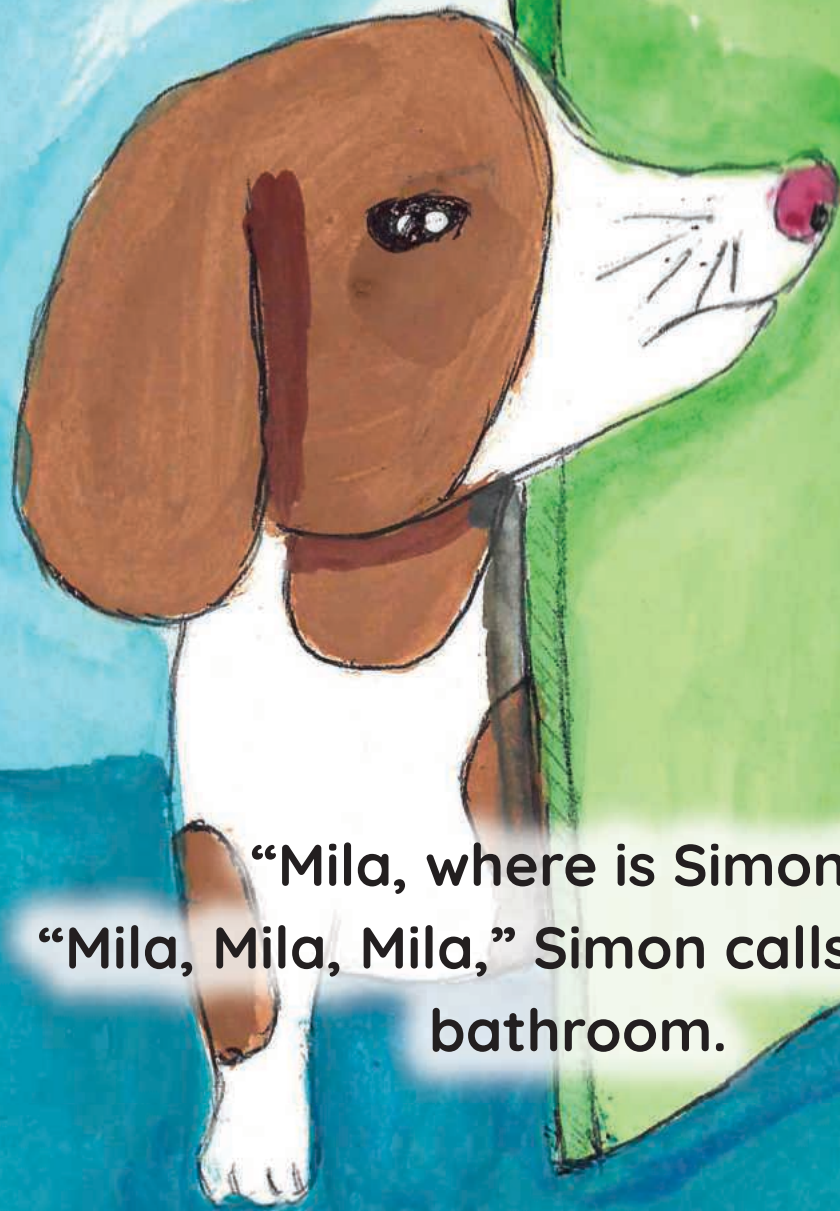
Granny is in the kitchen.

Is Simon hiding in the empty pot?

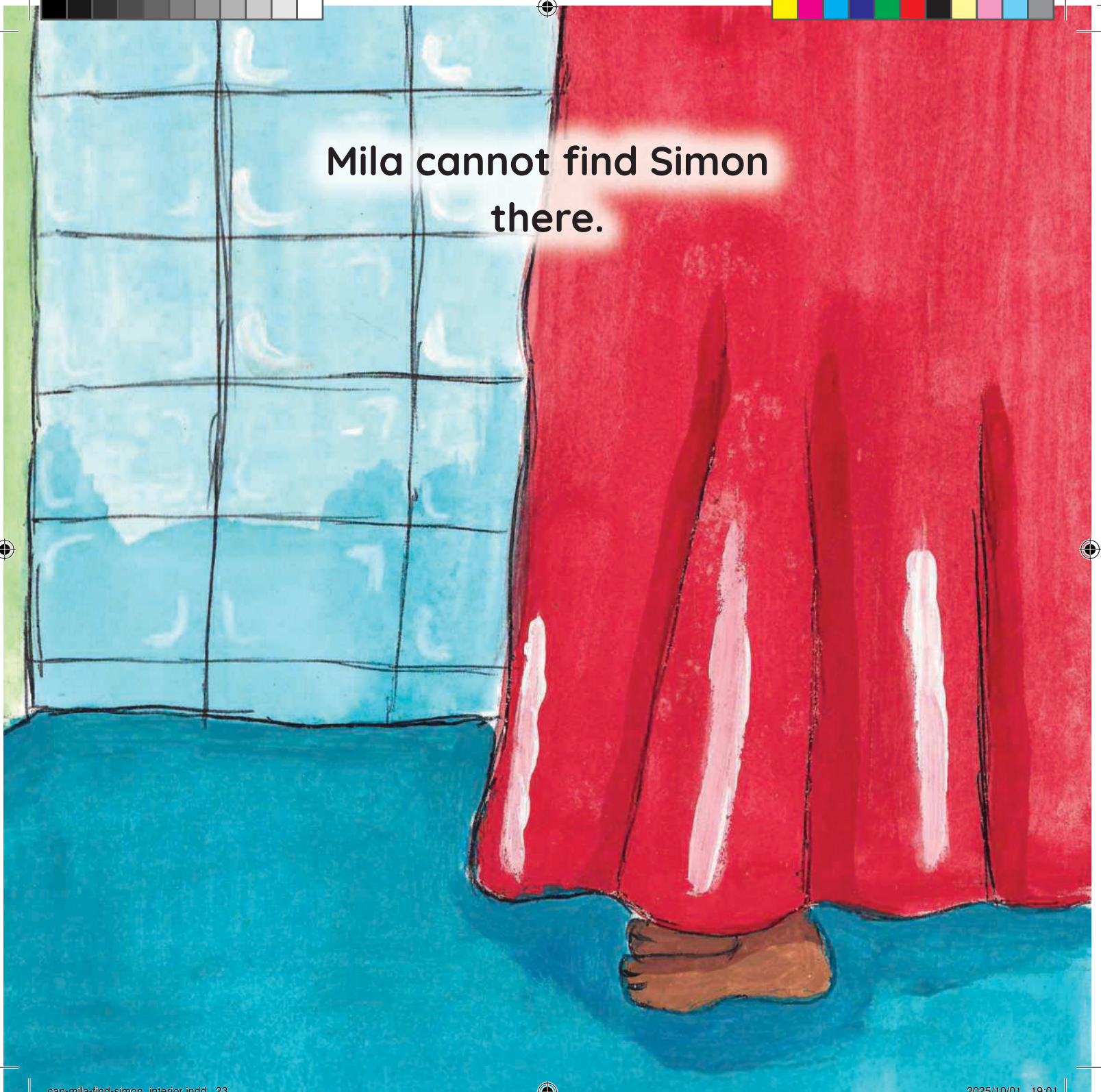




“Mila, where is Simon?”
“Mila, Mila, Mila,” Simon calls from the bathroom.

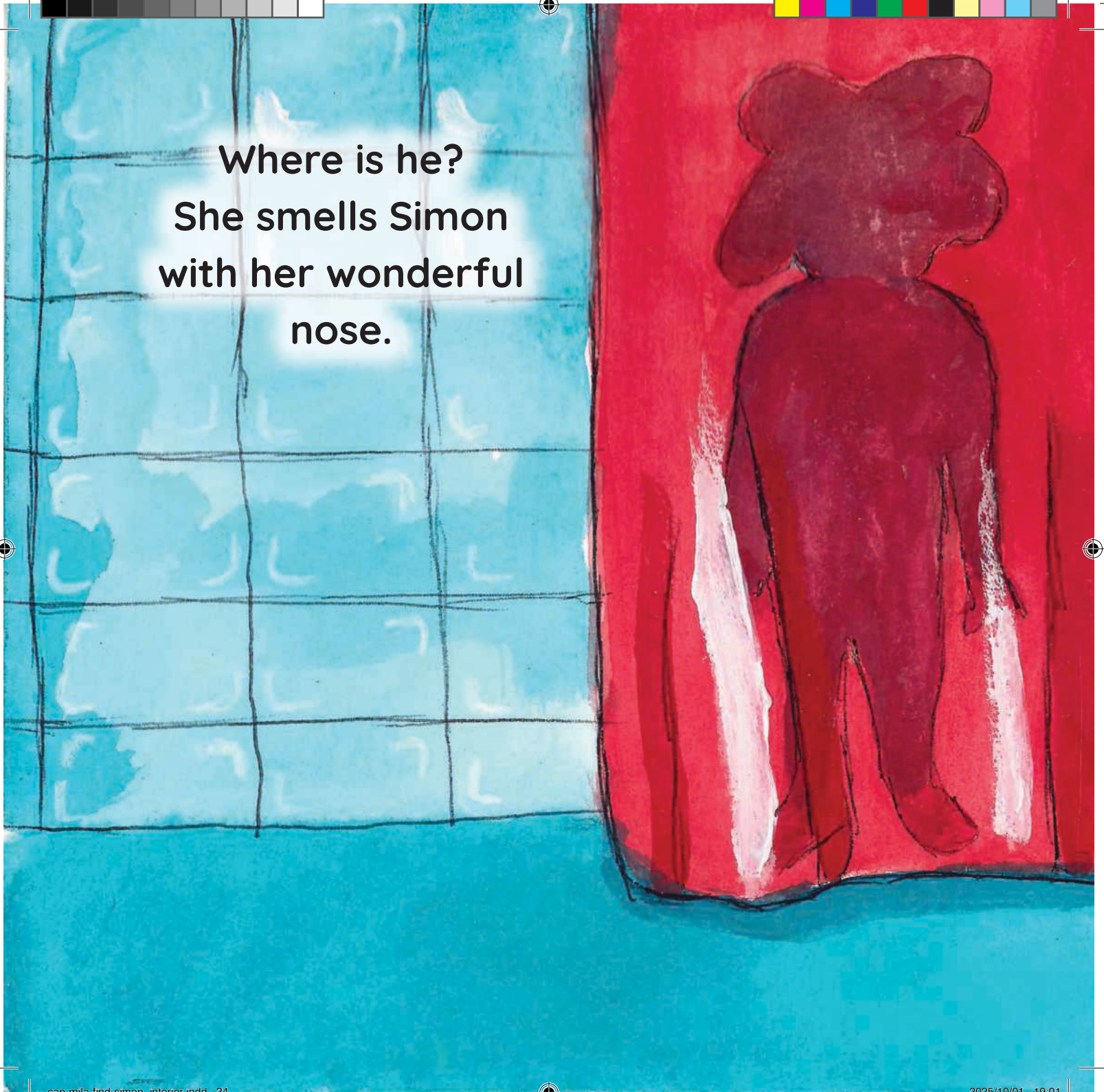


Mila cannot find Simon
