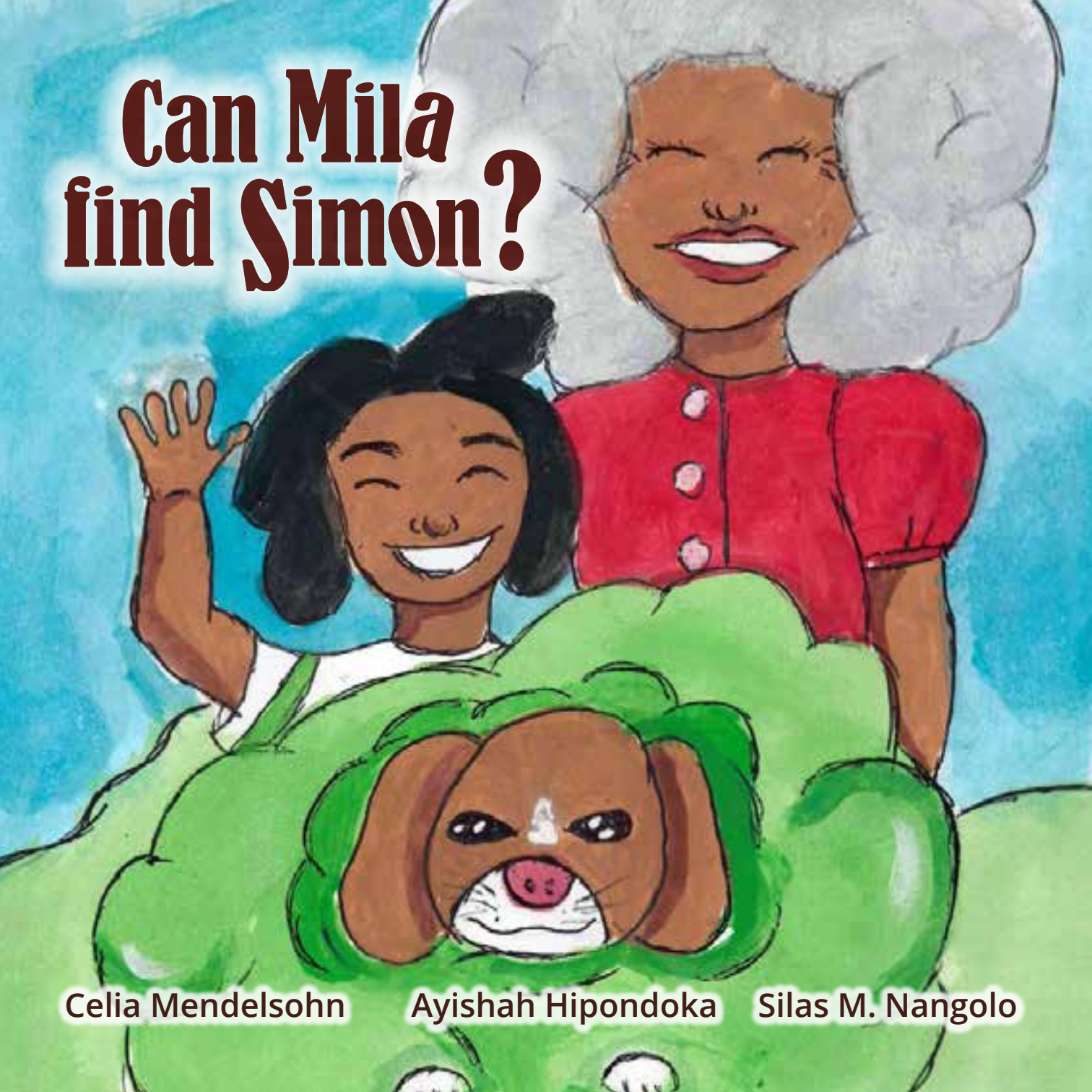

Simon!”

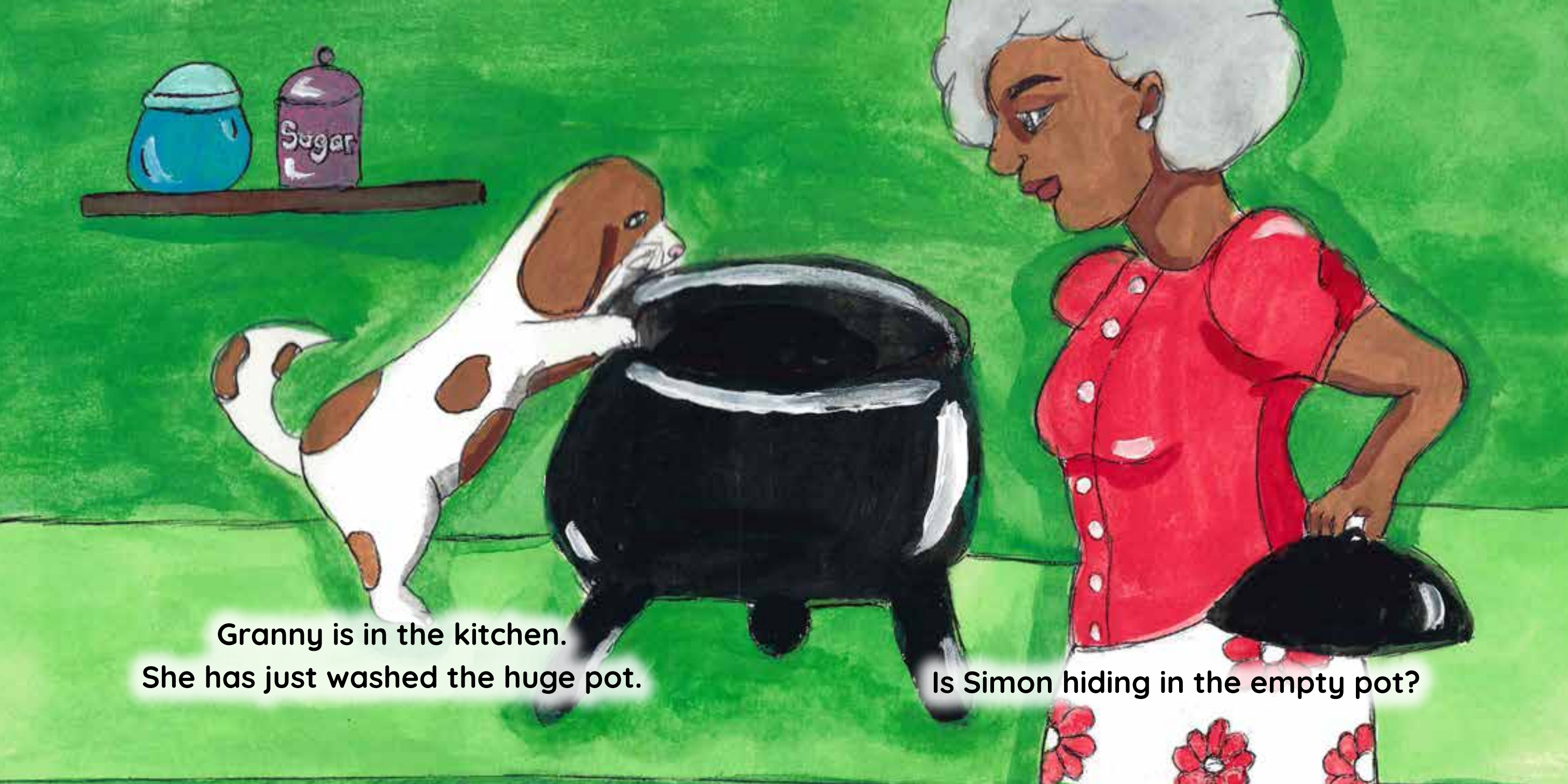


Where do YOU think Simon

Mila is looking for Simon.

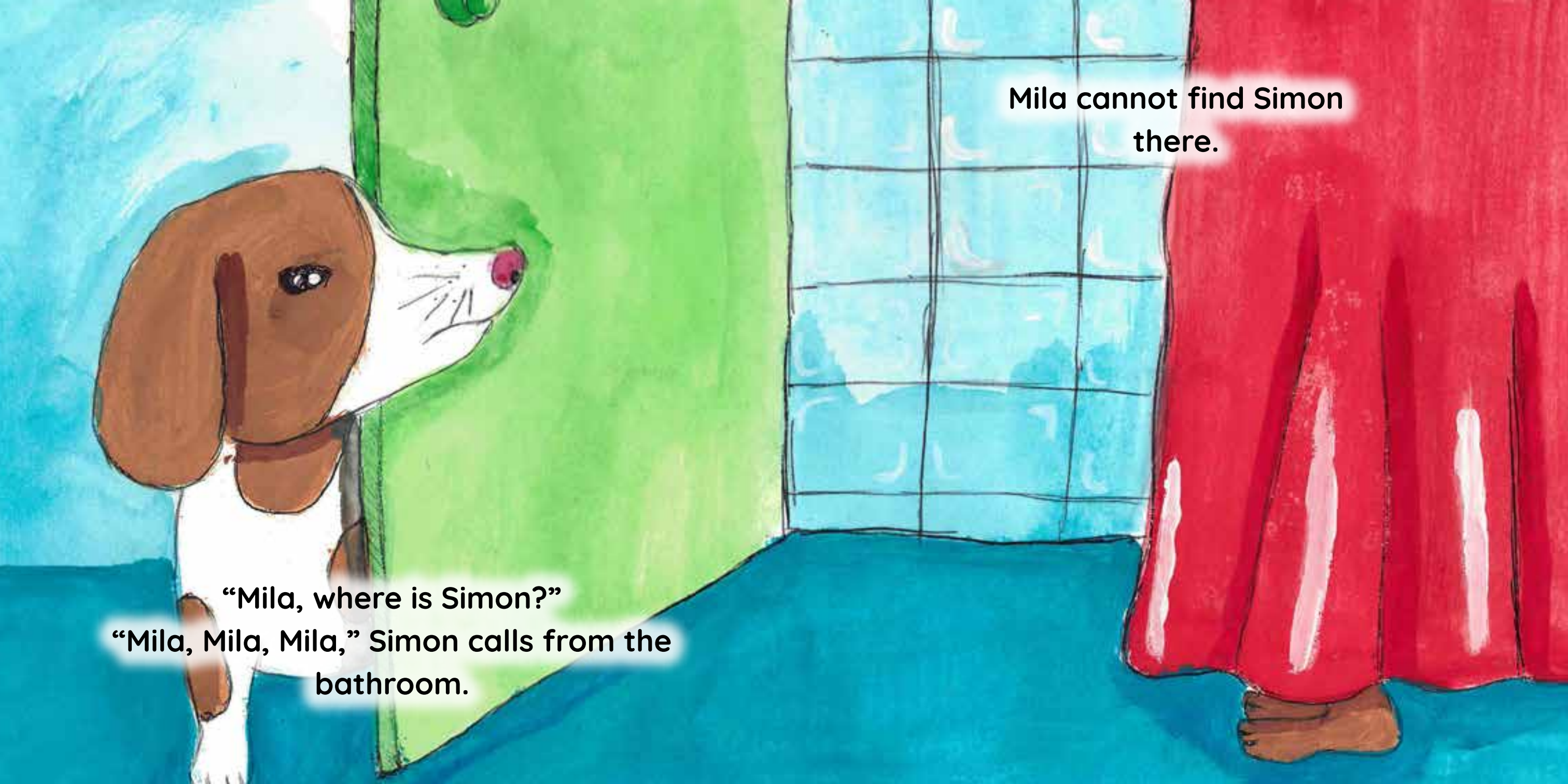
Under the bed.

“Mila, Mila, Mila,” Simon calls from the bathroom.

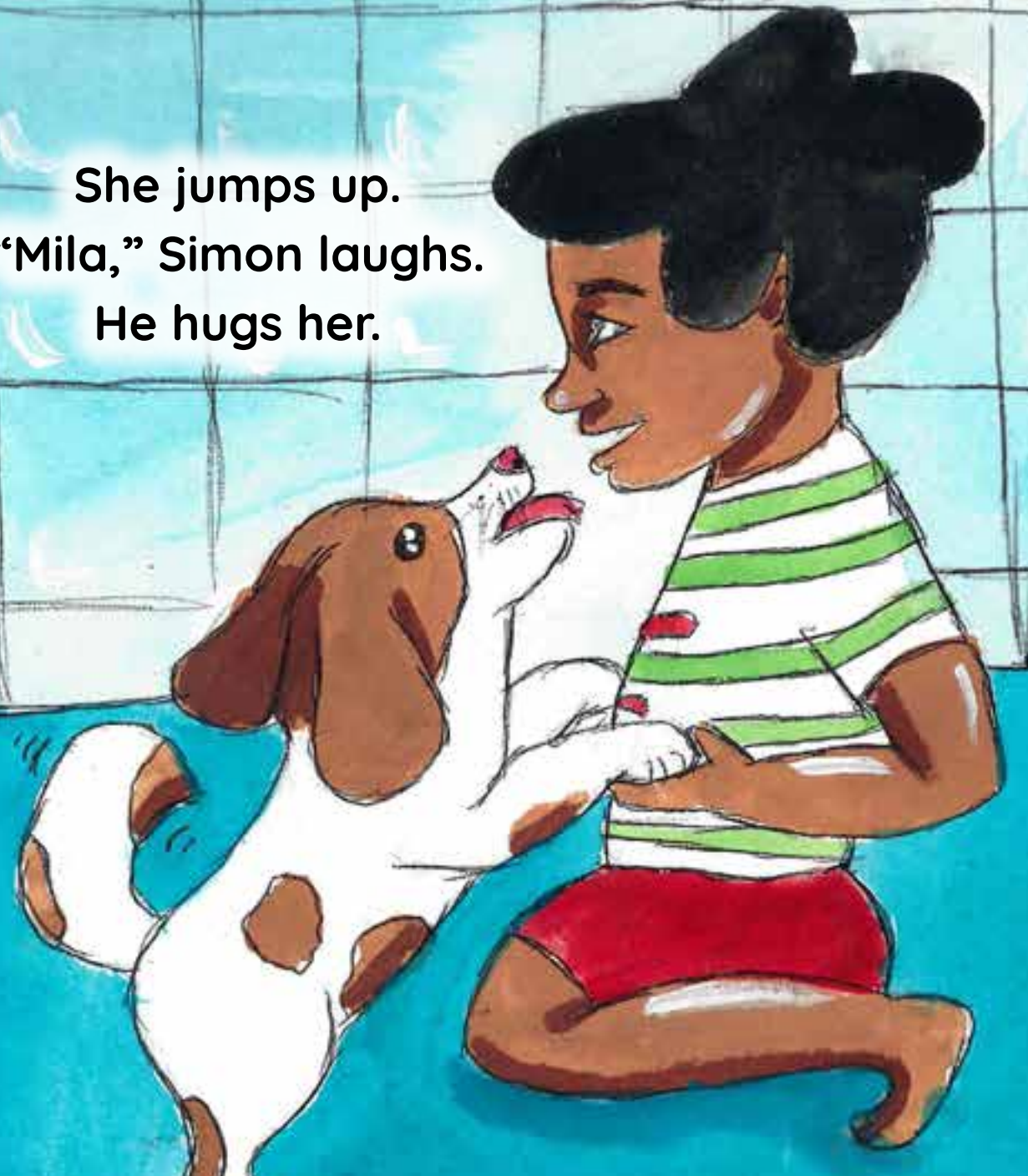
Where is he?
