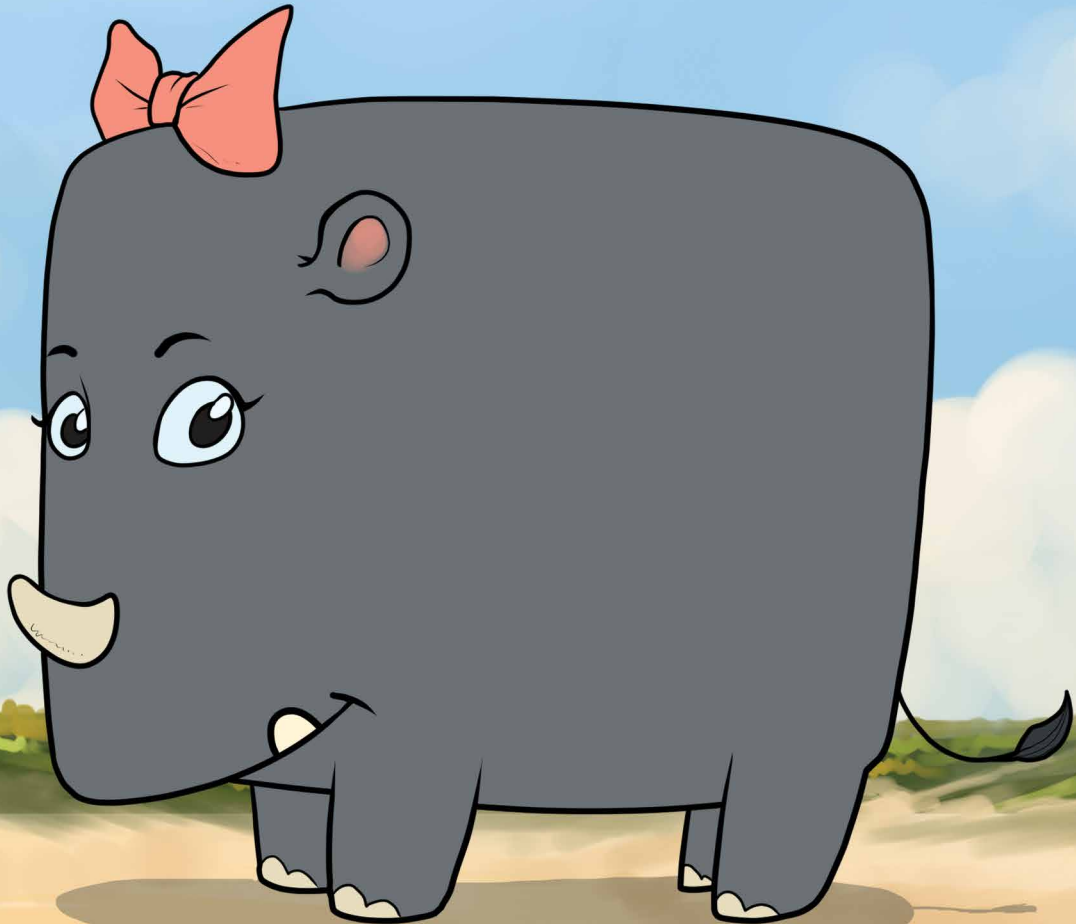

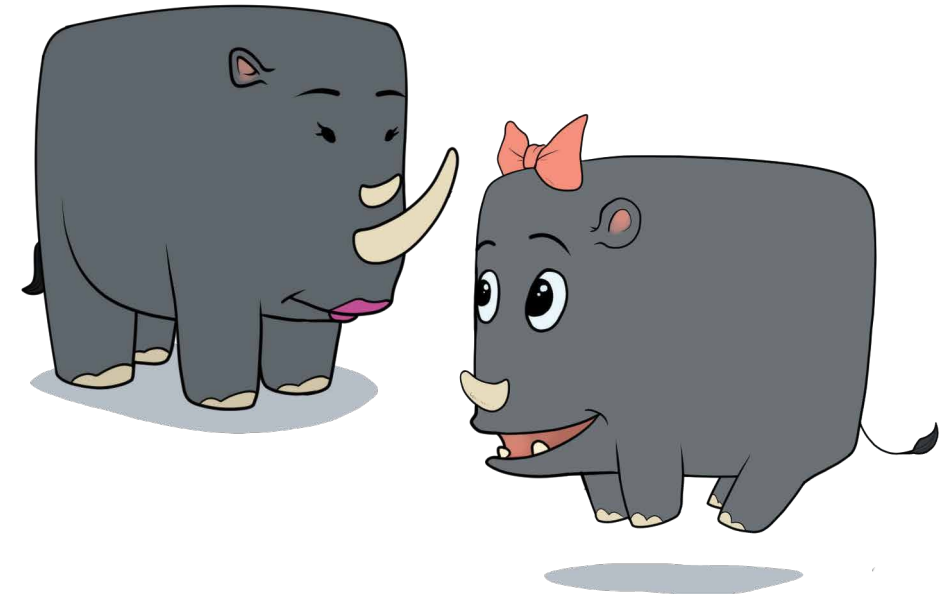

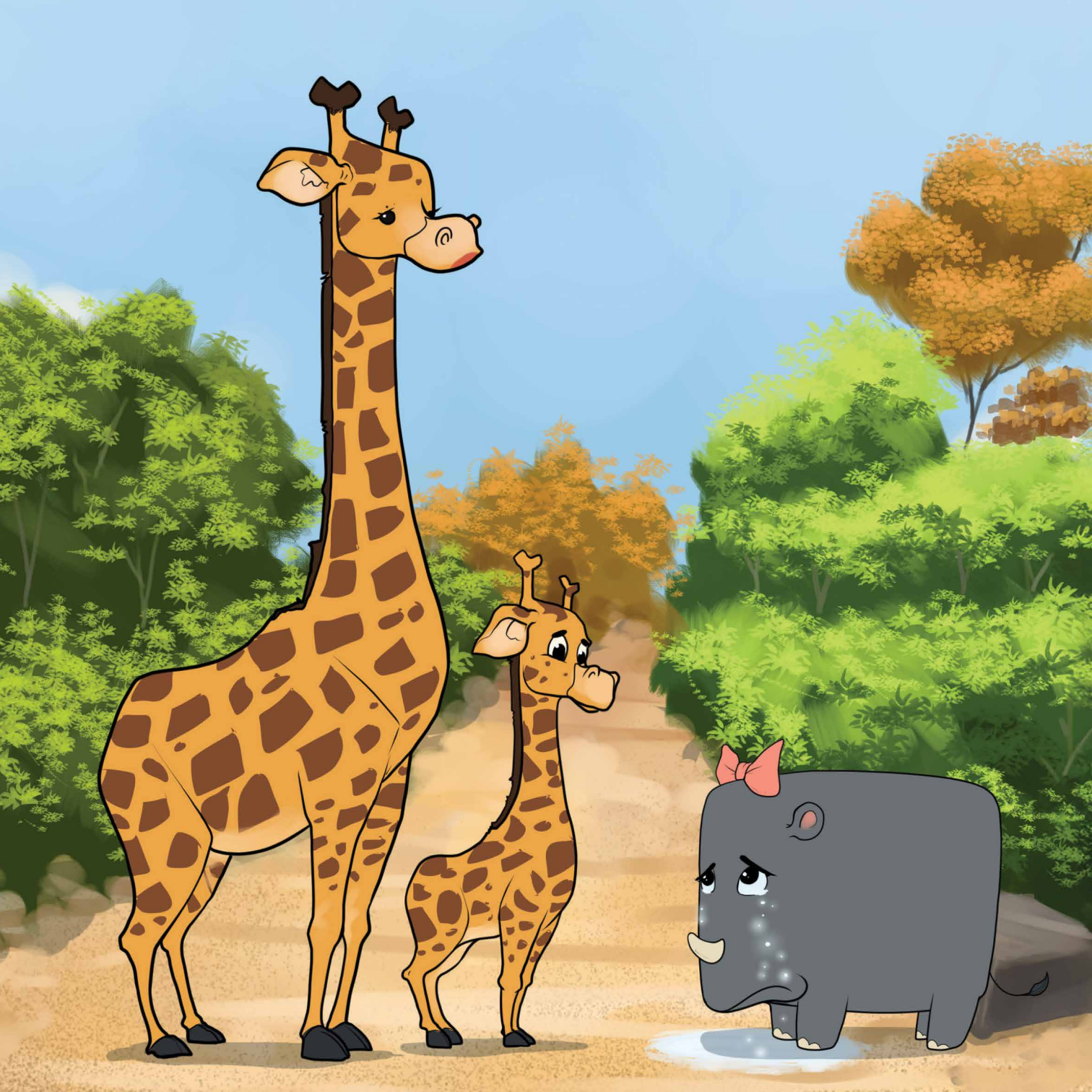

“Mama!” We found you!”

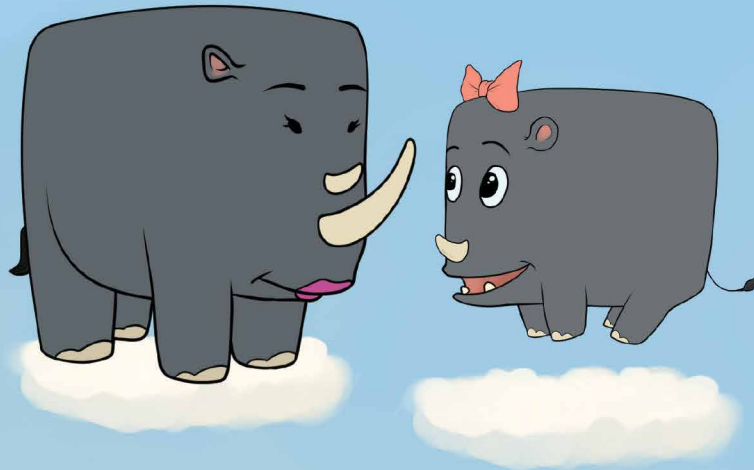
“Thank you for helping
