How to register for an exam:

- 1. Visit our website at https://www.goethe.de/ins/ph/en/index.html
- 2. Click on the exam level you want to take and find a schedule. Click on "Book" if the schedule you want is now available for booking.
- 3. Fill out the online registration form and upload a scanned copy of your valid ID (we only accept the following IDs: passport, NBI clearance, National ID, PRC ID, Driver's License or SSS UMID).
- 4. After submitting the registration form, you should receive an automated email with the payment instructions. Please check your Spam Folder as well. We accept payments via LBC door to door money transfers and online bank transfers.
- 5. Send your proof of payment via email to einschreibung-manila@goethe.de within 2 days.

For the Manila exams, we have two exam venues which are both located in Makati City (Adamson Centre and LKG Tower). The final exam venue will be sent via email 1 week prior to the exam date.

We ask of our examinees to be available full-time (usually 7.30am to 6pm) on the day of the examination. A more detailed schedule will be sent to you by e-mail approx. 1 week prior to the exam date.

Starting March 2024, digital certificates will be issued to those who took the exams and we will no longer provide printed certificates. Digital certificates will be available online 7 to 10 working days after the exam date.
