


If the course is for young people under 18, they create their personal account here.

To do this, enter the web address from Goethe-Institut Riga https://www.goethe.de/riga in your browser and click on my.Goethe.de at the top of the start page - "Login"






- Click "Register" and fill out the registration form.
- After filling out the form, selecting the required checkboxes and clicking "Register" you will receive an e-mail to the e-mail address provided in the registration form. The waiting time usually does not exceed a few minutes (in individual cases it may take a little longer).
- Click on the link you receive to confirm your registration.
- Close everything and go to the Goethe-Institut website again, to *my.Goethe.de* "Sign", enter your registered email and password, and click on "Sign up".



- Click on "My profile" and enter the personal information requested.
 Use Latin letters.
- Finally, click "Save".
- You can change your e-mail address or delete your account at any time. To do this, click on "Account settings" and use the options available there.



• Click on "Courses". Your customer number appears at the top (if not, on the course confirmation or invoice). Enter your customer number (this is also your registration code) further down and confirm by clicking "Save"
