Theme 10 - Session 3 (of 3)

Tipps and Tricks for your Club Session

- Watch the video before the lesson to see how to make the jumping Jack
- Pre-make one to show the learners
- Familiarise yourself with the new vocabulary
- Go over pronunciation help
- Have all your material laid out and ready to use
- Think of engaging gestures, routines and rituals to build a sense of togetherness and to aid repetition of vocabulary
- Keep it positive model correct use of language, instead of correcting mistakes
- Have fun and incorporate play and movement as much as possible
- Go on a language discovery journey with the children display curiosity

Objective

To be able to make a jumping Jack and label the body parts in German.

- Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio
- Felix and Franzi letterbox
- Felix and Franzi puppets
- Jumping Jack example (for Felix and Franzi)
- Coloured pens / pencils
- Split pins (5 per learner)
- Scissors
- Thread / string
- Small bead / button (to be used as a weight on the end of the string)
- Glue
- A copy of the Jumping Felix template for each learner, ideally on card. (Depending on the age of the learners, the leader may want to pre-cut the template pieces for each learner.)

5 min	Whole group	The children can recall the body parts in German	The learners look at the jumping Jack that Felix and Franzi are holding. Can the learners name the body parts of the "Hampelmann" ("jumping Jack")? Felix and Franzi take it in turns to ask "Was ist das?" ("What is that?") while pointing to a body part on the jumping Jack. The learners respond with the correct words in German. As always, model correct pronunciation and use the whiteboard to write up new vocabulary / vocabulary the learners have forgotten.	Interactive whiteboard/screen with internet access and audio Felix and Franzi puppets Jumping Jack example (for Felix and Franzi)	Was haben Felix und Franzi? – What do Felix und Franzi have? Felix und Franzi haben einen Hampelmann. – Felix and Franzi have a jumping Jack. Was ist das? – What is that? (Pointing to different body parts.) Das ist der Bauch / der Rücken / der Po / der Finger. – That is the stomach / back / bottom / finger. Wiederholen bitte Please repeat.
15 min	Whole group	The children can make their own jumping Jacks	The leader explains that the learners are now going to make their own jumping Felix. The leader demonstrates how to make the Juming Felix and ensures that the learners have time to follow each step. Do an example for the learners before they begin. You can also use the whiteboard to provide the key language required.
