





Papier-Nikolaus-Stiefel Santa boot made from paper

What you will need

- thicker, red paper (preferably coloured paper)
- white tissue paper
- red ribbon
- cotton wool
- glue
- adhesive tape
- scissors
- pencil
- **our template** (see next page 2)
- printer
- copy paper

Instructions

Step 1

Print out our template on normal paper.

Step 2

Cut out the components of the template – the mirrored boot and the elongated stripe – with the scissors.

Step 3

Transfer both templates onto red coloured paper using a pencil. Alternatively, print the template straight onto red card.

Step 4

Cut out the stripe and the mirrored boot from the coloured paper.

Step 5

Fold the mirrored boot at the folding marks you see on the template. Also fold over the flaps on the edge. You can now recognise the shape of the boot.



Step 6

Close the boot with the elongated element. Use adhesive tape for this purpose. These should join the two boot parts together in the inner – invisible – area. First attach the tape to the inside of one side of the boot and then fold the second side over it.



Important: The top of the Santa boot must remain open so that you can fill it with sweets and small aifts at the end.

Step 7

Cut off a piece of the white tissue paper.

Tip: Don't be too frugal here, as the paper should be attached to the top edge of the Santa boot and folded up so that you can tie it up after filling it.

Step 8

Stick the tissue paper to the top edge inside the boot

Step 9

Then attach some cotton wool around the opening of the boot – the easiest way to do this is with craft glue.

Step 10

Fill the Santa boot with treats and presents.
