







Hampel-Felix Felix Jumping Jack

What you will need

 cardboard in the colors green (DIN A3), yellow and white (DIN A4)

- removable adhesive tape
- 4 brass fasteners
- 1 thick cord (30 cm) and
 1 bead with a hole for the puller
- 1 sharp pencil
- 1 short string for the loop
- needle and wool
- glue
- scissors
- hole punch
- 1 black fiber pen

Instructions

Step 1

Print out the instructions and the Felix templates (F1, F2, F3).

Step 2

Transfer the outline of Felix's body, arms and legs (F1) onto the green cardboard:

- Cut out the body, arms and legs from the printed template.
- Stick them onto the green cardboard using removable adhesive tape.
- Draw along Felix's body, arms and legs with a pencil.
- Mark the joints (the small black dots) on the cardboard by going through the paper with the pencil so that the spot is visible on the cardboard.
- Then cut out all the green parts.

Step 3

Transfer the outline of Felix's belly (F2) onto the vellow cardboard:

- Cut out the belly from the printed template.
- Stick it onto the yellow cardboard using removable adhesive tape.
- Draw along Felix's belly with a pencil.
- Mark the joints (the small black dots) on the cardboard by going through the paper with the pencil so that the spot is visible on the cardboard.

- Then cut out the yellow belly.

Step 4

Transfer the outline of Felix's eyes and mouth (F3) onto the white cardboard:

- Cut out the eyes and mouth from the printed template.
- Stick them onto the white cardboard using removable adhesive tape.
- Draw along Felix's eyes and mouth with a pencil.
- Then cut out the eyes and mouth.

Sten 5

Trace all the contours with the black fiber pen (i.e. along all the edges) so that all the body parts have a black border.

Step 6

Draw Felix's pupils in his eyes with the black fiber pen.

Step 7

Draw the two red circles on the left and right of Felix's mouth with the red fiber-tip pen.

Step 8

Glue Felix's stomach, eyes and mouth onto his body.

Step 9

Pre-punch the holes at the joints for the brass fasteners on both arms, legs and the body with a hole punch. If you can't reach all the places with the hole punch, you can also simply press the holes into the cardboard with a firm pencil and cut off what sticks out with the scissors. Don't forget the hole in the head for the suspension.

Step 10

Place the arms and legs under the body and insert the brass fasteners through the holes and bend them slightly. Do not bend them too tightly, otherwise the arms and legs will be immobile.

Step 11

Use a needle and string to join the arms together horizontally on the back: Poke a small hole through the cardboard of the arms with the needle and attach the thick cord to each arm with a knot. Then do the same with the legs.

Step 12

Knot the thick cord to the string at the height of the legs. Now attach the bead to the lower end of the string.

Step 13

Pull a small loop through the hole at the head as a hanger.

Your Hampel-Felix is ready!
