We wish to clarify that the recent situation that saw our web portal open inadvertently before the communicated registration opening time, 9th September at 9:00 AM, was due to a technical issue. The new registration date for all prospective B1 exam candidates is set for Thursday, 11th September to afford all our clients a fair chance to register.
