

Das FilmFest Ticket Competition

- Terms and Conditions

1. Employees of the Goethe-Institut, legal partners of the Das FilmFest project, and their families, or anyone else professionally associated with the competition are not eligible to enter.
2. To enter this competition, applicants must fill in the online survey including their email and submit it. Entry is restricted to one submission per person and once submitted, entries cannot be amended in any way.
3. Rights and Permissions: By submitting their entry, participants grant the contest organisers a non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use the answers (incl. quotes) gathered in the survey.
4. The winners will be selected through a lottery system conducted by a Goethe-Institut employee.
5. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final, and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. The selection is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. All entries must be received by 23:59 on Sunday 12th October 2025.
7. Late, illegible, incomplete, defaced, or corrupt entries will not be accepted. No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries and proof of sending will not be accepted as proof of receipt.
8. The winners will be contacted by email before the 13th October 2025 midnight. Should the Promoter be unable to contact a winner, or should a winner be unable to confirm their acceptance before 15th October 2025 midnight of the prize, the Promoter reserves the right to award the prize to an alternative winner, drawn in accordance with these terms and conditions.
9. The prizes as described are available on the date of publication. Should a prize become unavailable, then a reasonable equivalent will be provided.
10. The prizes are nontransferable and there is no cash alternative.
11. Entrants' data will be used for the purpose of administration of this competition and in accordance with the permissions granted or withheld at the point of entry.

Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of a prize impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the Promoter and accordingly the Promoter may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the Promoter as a result thereof.
