| Short project summary <p>The project EU4Belarus: Mobility Scheme for Targeted People-to-People Contacts IV (MOST IV) runs from October 2024 to August 2027 and aims to improve the professional competences and future opportunities of Belarusian professionals, both in the country and in exile. Through a permanent mobility scheme, participants can engage in short-term visits, long-term internships, and multi-stop exchanges. These opportunities focus on key sectors such as society, culture, business, education, health and care, and sustainability. At least 670 mobilities are planned, enabling participants to establish professional partnerships, expand networks, and share expertise with EU counterparts. Complementing this, the project's community-building component creates a supportive environment for applicants and alumni. Through networking events and information sessions, MOST IV fosters trust-based relationships and peer-to-peer exchange, ensuring Belarusian professionals remain connected to European expertise.</p> | |
