



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Goethe-Institut Canada Inc.
(the “Goethe-Institut Toronto”)

Camp Go Goethe!
Goethe-Institut Toronto Mach Break Camp 2026
(the “Camp”)

1. **Fees:** The fees to be paid to participate in the Camp shall be those set out in the Goethe-Institut Toronto’s Camp registration form from time to time. The Goethe-Institut Toronto may at its sole discretion increase fees at any time without notice.

2. **Registration:** Subject to these Terms and Conditions, registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Submission of a registration form not accompanied by payment in accordance with these Terms and Conditions does not guarantee enrollment in the Camp.

3. **Terms of Payment:** Fees are payable at the time of registration. Payment can be made via e-transfer to Info-toronto@goethe.de

A child will not be entitled to attend the Camp until full payment of all fees is received.

4. Refunds / Changes:

4.1 To be eligible for a fee refund, registered Camp participants must submit a written notice of withdrawal (the “**Notice of Withdrawal**”) to the Goethe-Institut Toronto at the following email address: daycamps-toronto@goethe.de. If the Notice of Withdrawal is received by the Goethe-Institut Toronto on or before **March 6, 2026**, the fee will be refunded in full minus an administration fee of \$30 (sales tax included). No refund is granted in the case of withdrawal after **March 6, 2026** (subject to a limited exception in individual cases and at the Goethe-Institut’s sole discretion, where the student has provided a doctor’s note indicating an illness or accident). Any other fees, including materials fees are non-refundable. The Goethe-Institut Toronto will not provide vouchers or credit towards registration for future camps.

4.2 No refund will be provided in the event a child misses a Camp Day as a result of a failure to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

5. Camp Placement / Total Enrollment:

5.1 The Camp is intended for children aged 6-12 years old.



5.2 Total Camp enrollment is a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of fifteen (15) participants.

6. Cancellations:

The Goethe-Institut Toronto reserves the right to cancel the Camp, for any reason whatsoever, in particular if enrollment is insufficient on the Camp commencement date. In the case of cancellation, the Goethe-Institut Toronto will offer participants the opportunity to move to the next PA-Day Camp (at no charge), if space is available, or to receive a full refund of all fees paid. The Goethe-Institut Toronto will endeavour to notify participants promptly of any Camp cancellations.

7. General terms:

7.1 All participants must abide by all established rules and regulations of the Goethe-Institut Toronto. The Goethe-Institut Toronto reserves the right to dismiss any participant who, at the Goethe-Institut's sole discretion, poses an unreasonable disruption or is a hazard to the safety and well-being of other participants and/or the Goethe-Institut Toronto staff. Dismissed participants are not eligible for any refund.

7.2 The Goethe-Institut Toronto is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

7.3 All participants must provide the following documents (together, the **"Enrollment Forms"**), fully completed and signed, prior to the Camp commencement date:

- Parental Consent, Release of Liability and Indemnity.
- Media Consent & Release.
- Emergency Contact Form; and
- Medical Authorization.

7.4 A child will not be entitled to attend the Camp until these Terms and Conditions and all Enrollment Forms, fully completed and signed, have been received by the Goethe-Institut Toronto.
