EU4CULTURE IMPACT IN THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA

Improved cultural policy making and enriched cultural scene in non-capital cities

- **2 non-capital cities** developed their Cultural Strategies.
- City of **Cahul** implemented its Cultural Strategy.
- City of Orhei implemented selected actions from its Cultural Strategies.

Results of Cahul Cultural Strategy:

- **Enriched cultural scene of the city** through large-scale cultural events;
- **Improved and diversified cultural services in the city** through modernised cultural infrastructure and increased number of cultural events;
- **Strengthened cultural and creative industries** through elaboration of a Creative Industries Development Plan and supporting promotional activities by Moldovan authors.

Strengthened civil society, improved cross-sectoral cooperation

EU4Culture supported independent organisations to implement **cultural and cross-innovation projects**.

Highlights Cultural and Cross-Innovation projects:

 **Unveiling Moldovan Folklore:** Increasing the visibility of local artists from non-capital cities through seven video stories on intangible cultural heritage and a documentary about artistic experiences.

 **Moldo Crescendo Musical Interpretation Masterclass:** Enhancing music education in Orhei and Cahul with masterclasses by renowned musicians.

 **Festival de (C)arte Creative:** Promoting literature and publishing sector with a four-day creative industries festival during Library Days 2024 in Orhei Municipality.

 **Creative City Exchange Moldova, Armenia, Ukraine:** Increasing regional cooperation and strengthening the capacity of cultural institutions and hubs in three countries.

Increased opportunities, international network and strengthened collaboration

With the support of EU4Culture **45** artists and cultural professionals from the Republic of Moldova implemented **international mobility projects**, established international partnerships, exchanged knowledge and strengthened their capacities.

The EU4Culture Local Festival: **City Stories, Diverse Voices – Illuminate**. Amplify in Cahul attracted up to 400 attendees. The event raised awareness of innovative approaches, showcased regional and intercity performances, **fostered community engagement, and strengthened cultural dialogue**.

Over 61 cultural professionals (public and private) from **the Republic of Moldova** increased their knowledge on internationalisation, cultural enterprise and management and cultural indicators.
