Lesson 1: Hello and how are you?

What this on-demand lesson is about

- An introduction to learning another language
- Getting to know Franzi and Felix who will help us learn German
- Greeting others and saying goodbye
- The *Hello* and the *Goodbye* song
- Say how you are feeling

Tips and Tricks

- Go over pronunciation help
- Have all your material laid out and ready to use
- Think of engaging gestures, routines and rituals to build a sense of togetherness and to aid repetition of vocabulary
- The video can be paused at any time, or content can be replayed
- Keep it positive - model correct use of language, instead of correcting mistakes
- Have fun and incorporate play and movement as much as possible
- Go on a language discovery journey with the children

Learning Objectives

In this on-demand lesson, students learn (how) to...

- **Listen and repeat short German phrases** with correct pronunciation.
- **Follow simple classroom instructions in German**, such as *Sprecht nach! Wir singen! Wir lesen!*.
- **Take part in German songs, speaking, and movement activities.**
- **Show confidence speaking German in a group**, for example by greeting classmates.
- **Repeat and pronounce simple German words and phrases** through songs, choral speaking, and repetition.
- **Respond physically and verbally to prompts** (e.g. pointing, waving, speaking along).
- **Participate confidently in group interaction**, such as greeting classmates and speaking together.
- **Develop curiosity and positive attitudes toward learning German** through characters, storytelling, and play.

Encourage students to listen first, then repeat the song with the students joining in and/or clapping the rhythm to the song. • Wave to greet Felix and Franzi. Support students to identify Germany and locate Berlin on the map. Encourage students to point to places on the screen or a map and repeat key phrases "Das ist Deutschland" and "Das ist Berlin." 05:40-06:43	Whole group	<p>Students are able to say goodbye to Felix and Franzi by singing the song and using German goodbye phrases</p> <p>The worksheet can be used as a plenary activity either directly after watching the video, during the lesson or as a follow-up activity before the next lesson.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Saying goodbye to Felix and Franzi: Sing Felix and Franzi back into their letterbox using the music. Encourage students to listen first, then repeat the song and participating with actions such as clapping or waving <i>Tip: Encourage students to wave goodbye to Felix and Franzi.
