The internship involves working on all scheduled cultural projects, with special focus on the **bangaloREsidency**, our artist-in-residence programme, which will take place from September 5 to October 31, 2026.

Your tasks will include

- Assisting the cultural team in all areas, especially the **bangaloREsidency**, including planning, preparation, execution and documentation of cultural programmes.
- Preparing and compiling materials and information for public relations, both on- and offline.
- Developing social media content and campaigns for cultural programmes, with focus on Instagram, YouTube.
- Assisting with audio-visual documentation of events and archiving.
- Close coordination with individual artists-in-residence (**bangaloREsidents**) via the “buddy” system, including organisation of events/projects and day-to-day support.
- Coordination between the **bangaloREsidents**, partner institutions and the Institute.

You should have

- Excellent command of English language, knowledge of Kannada/German will be an added advantage.
- Higher semester of a university degree or bachelor’s degree in the humanities or social sciences.
- Experience in and flair for creative social media.
- Intimate knowledge of the Bangalore art/culture scene (we are looking for candidates based in Bangalore).
- Willingness to work evenings/weekends if required.
- Capability of working independently and dealing with stress.
- Ability to perform effectively in a team.
