



DLL Programme GI Kenia 2026-2028

The DLL Programme provides the methodological and didactic basis for teaching German as a foreign language and is therefore at the core of the teacher-training leading to the Grünes Diplom of the Goethe-Institut.

The next **Deutsch Lehren Lernen (DLL)** training cycle at the Goethe-Institut Kenia will run from **11th May 2026 to 12th May 2028**. The Goethe-Institut Kenya invites applications from suitable candidates for the course based on this programme. Applicants from the East African region shall have priority in the selection.

Participation in the DLL-Programme is also open to candidates who do not intend to teach at a Goethe-Institut.

Prerequisites

- Bachelor's degree (in any field)
- Interest in the language, arts, and culture of German-speaking countries
- Motivation and interest in teaching German as a foreign language
- German language proficiency at level B2 or higher in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
- C1-level German proficiency must be achieved, and proof must be submitted no later than 1st September 2027
- Teaching experience
- Basic computer literacy and the ability to conduct online work and research
- Ability to work independently

Formalities

- The training programme is offered on a scholarship basis
- The duration of the training programme is two years

The **application deadline** for the DLL Teacher Training programme commencing in May 2026 is the **3rd of April 2026**.
