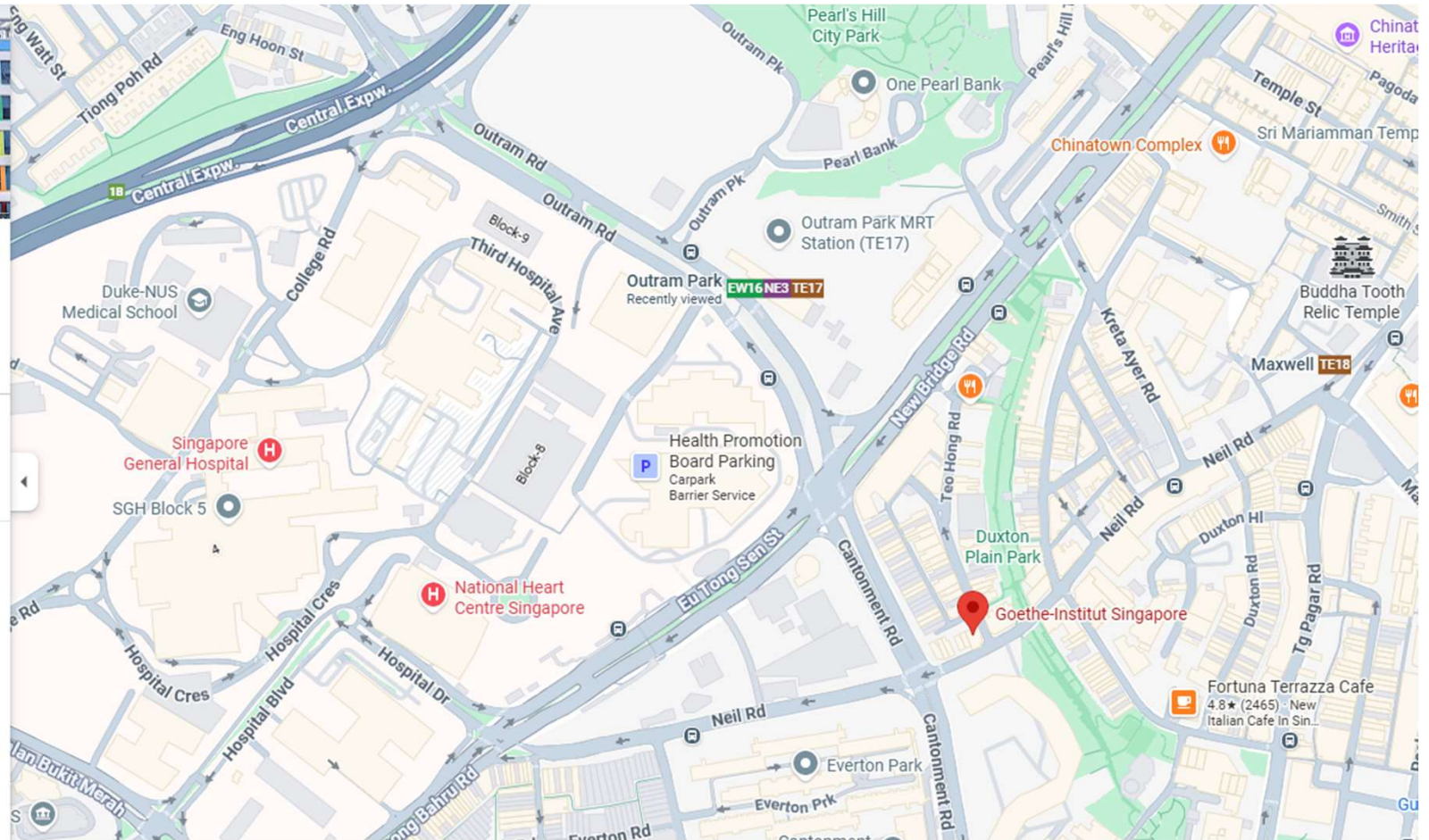

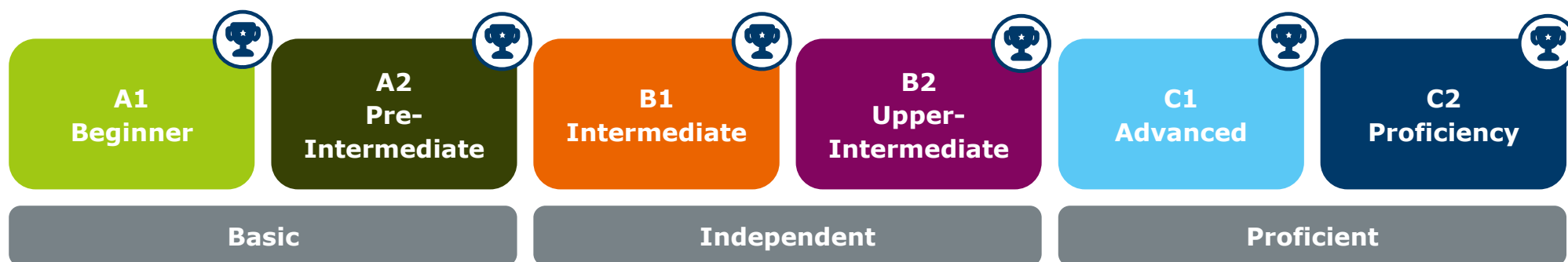

CEFR – COMMON EUROPEAN FRAMEWORK of REFERENCE for LANGUAGES

an **international standard** for describing language ability through “**can-do**” statements across listening, reading, speaking, and writing at **six levels** from A1 (beginner) to C2 (mastery), developed by the **Council of Europe** and officially introduced in **2001**



A1	Can understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type. Can introduce him/herself and others and can ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people he/she knows and things he/she has. Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.
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MODULAR THIRD LANGUAGE PROGRAMME

Project by Ministry of Education Singapore (started in 2023)

Provides secondary school students with the opportunity to learn a new language and discover another culture

Languages currently available: French and German

Modular German lessons conducted by Goethe-Institut Singapore

Lesson fees fully subsidised by MOE

Students' costs: cost of transportation, textbooks, other lesson materials

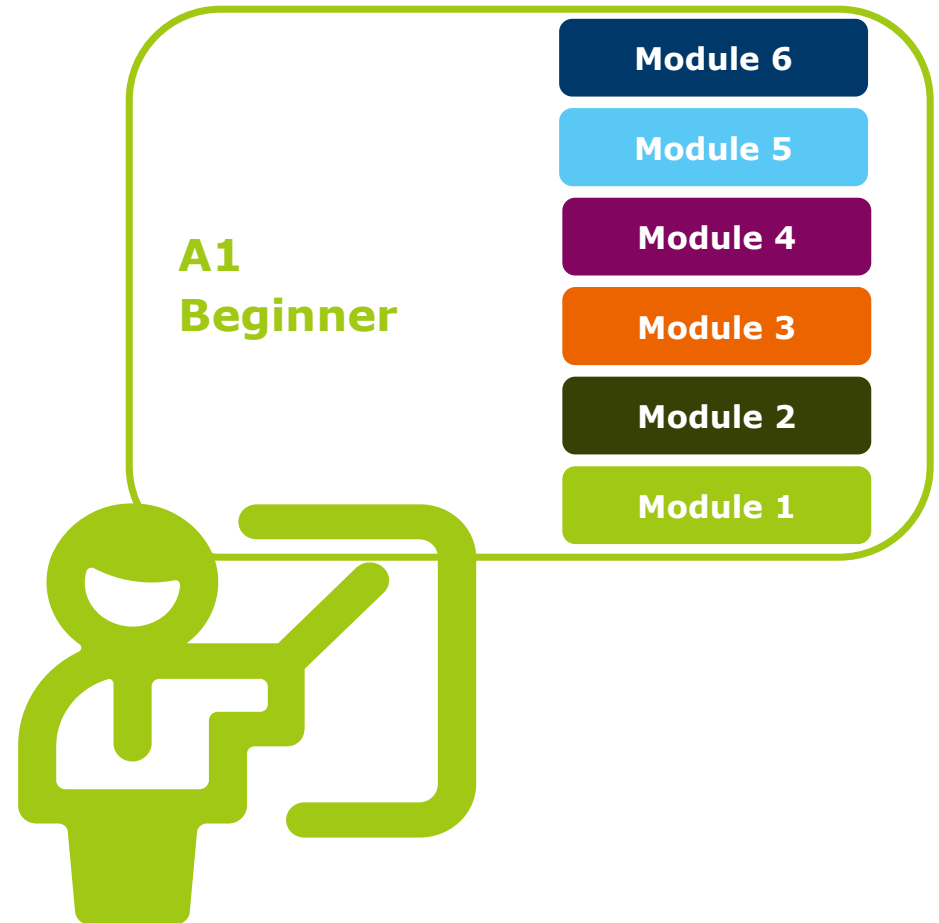

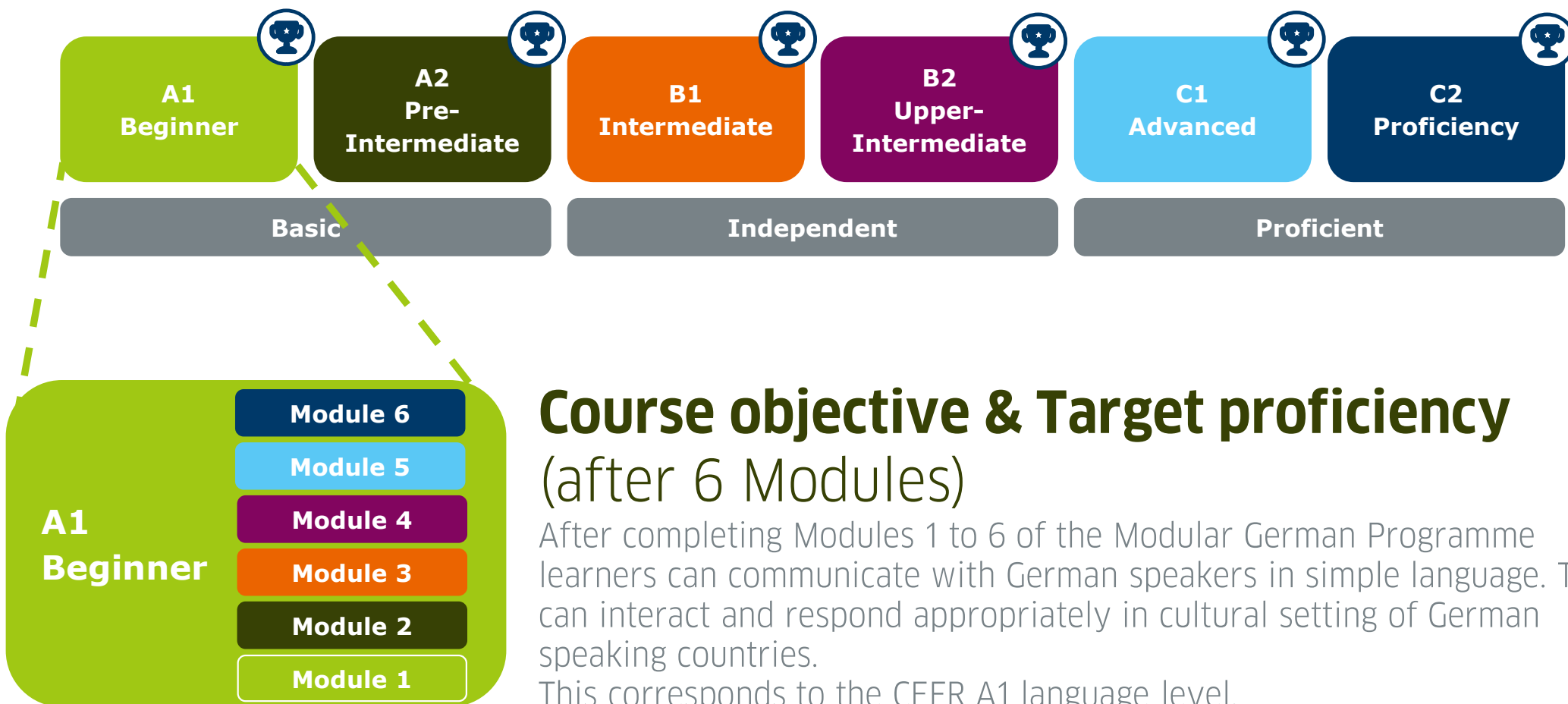

	Topics	Learning Goals By the end of the module, students will...
Module 1	Greetings, names, spelling, well-being, age, telephone numbers, hobbies, number, countries, languages	• be familiar with German pronunciation. • know basic sentence structures in German. • be able to introduce themselves and their countries in German. • learn about the geography and culture of various regions in Germany.
Module 2	Name of own school name and class, subjects, people, content of schoolbag, activities in school, weekdays, time of day, daily activities and routine, appointments, meeting a friend	• be able to have simple conversations about school life. • know about the school culture in Germany. • be able to describe their daily activities. • learn more about common activities German people take part in on weekends.
Module 3	Groceries and drinks, shops, prices, personal preferences, family members, pets, professions	• be able to buy food at a kiosk in school. • be able to describe their food habits, likes and dislikes. • be able to introduce their families and pets to others. • know different jobs and state which job they prefer. • be able to give simple instructions.
Module 4	Afternoon activities (ECA), invitations (accept and decline), abilities and intentions, the body, illness	• know about different afternoon activities of German students, • be able to talk about their own activities and what they can and cannot do well. • know how to plan activities with friends, invite friends and respond to invitations. • be able to describe different kinds of pain and dos and don'ts when in pain. • know some German athletes and talk about their favorite sports.
Module 5	Places in a city, transport, living spaces, rooms, furniture, festivals, birthdays, clothes, colors, likes and dislikes, description of people	• know about institutions, shops, modes of transport and neighborhoods in German cities • be able to describe and talk about their city and their activities • know about seasons, festivals, birthdays and clothes in Germany. • be able to describe how they celebrate their birthday and congratulate others.
Module 6	Activities after school, reading and writing school magazines, understanding and giving directions in a city, weather, travel, ordering food and drinks	• know about activities after school in Germany • be able to plan activities in and after school and make arrangements to meet. • know about holiday destinations in German, Switzerland and Austria • be able to describe their holiday activities, the weather and write a postcard to a friend.

PREREQUISITES

Module 1

No prior knowledge of German needed

Student must be interested to get to know another language and culture

Students/Families should be willing to bear the cost for the course book (S\$ 42.50)

From Module 2 onwards

Students must have either completed the previous module OR

have some prior exposure to the language AND pass a placement interview

Online Placement Interviews: via Zoom, 15.6.-17.6., 5-6pm

If your child is selected for the interview, you will receive an email invitation to book a slot.

EXPECTATIONS

1. Attend weekly lessons consistently and arrive on time for class
(Students arrive and go home independently)
2. Display good conduct when attending lessons
3. Do regular homework and revision in between classes
4. Participate actively in class and project work
5. Interact respectfully with classmates, teachers and other people around

ABSENCES

Attendance is taken at the beginning each lesson and shared with MOE
Unexcused absence is not permitted (Parents & School will be informed)

In case of absence:

Parents should inform the class teacher as soon as possible by email of a students' absence.

Students are independently responsible to revise class content and proactively approach the teacher, if they have questions.

Please reduce absences to a minimum to ensure a good learning experience.

ASSESSMENT, PASSING CRITERIA & CERTIFICATE

Course assessment

- Oral participation in class & completion of weekly homework
- Video project in weeks 7/8

Learners advance to the next module with an overall passing mark of 60% or higher.

Video project

To demonstrate their ability to communicate in German, students produce a short video as a group project to document their learning and also give feedback on other videos.

Video preparation time: Week 3-6

Video upload: Week 7

Video feedback: before Week 8

Assessment on content points, fluency, pronunciation and accurate use of learned phrases

Attendance Certificate

Learners must attend min. 6 out of 8 lessons to receive an attendance certificate.

FURTHER PROCESS

Application open until 5 June, 12pm (selection is NOT first-come-first-serve, so no rush!)

Fill out the application form diligently together with your child

Parent consent is mandatory for several items

Further process

1. After 5 June: Allocation of spaces based on selected days (computerized randomized balloting)
2. Direct offer: to 20 students per class (by email)
Very important: Must accept by responding to the confirmation email
Module 1: Book fee to be paid before the start of the class
Otherwise, space will be forfeited
3. 5 waitlist spaces per class (by email)
When a space becomes available, waitlisted students will receive offer by email
Very important: Must accept by responding to the confirmation email
Module 1: Book fee to be paid before the start of the class
Otherwise, space will be forfeited
4. Module 2 students, who are selected for placement interview, receive invitation to book slot (by email)
Very important: Book a slot as soon as possible
After successful booking we will send you the Zoom link by email.
The seat in the class will only be confirmed after successful completion of the placement interview
