



Goethe-Institut Gulf Region: Supplementary Terms and Conditions in the Event of an Alarm

For safety reasons, the exam may be interrupted, suspended, postponed, or canceled entirely at any time.

In the event of an alarm during the exam, examinees are required to leave their exam materials on their desks, exit the exam room immediately, and proceed to the hallway.

Depending on the duration of the alarm or the acute security situation, the Goethe-Institut may cancel the exam and offer an alternative exam date.

In the event of a cancellation, the relevant exam section will be repeated at a later date using a new exam set.

An exam day, including interruptions, may last a maximum of 8 hours.

The duration of the grading process may be delayed due to the security situation.

The exam fee will be refunded beyond the provisions of §6 of the Examination Regulations in the following cases:

- The examinee is unable to attend an alternative exam date after the exam has been canceled or postponed by the Goethe-Institut.
- The exam is canceled entirely for security reasons.
