**FUTURE FASHION – ENHANCING LIFE** is part of **IKAT/eCUT**, a regional project by the Goethe-Institut exploring the past, present and future of textiles in Southeast Asia, Australia and New Zealand as traditional cultural craft, a material for art and part of the digital technology revolution.

The Goethe-Institut is organizing a **workshop, seminar and fashion show** around the topic of smart textiles and wearable technologies. The programme seeks to promote young designers and encourage dialogue among professionals in a diverse range of areas such as fashion, material science, digital technology and social product design.

18 participants will have the opportunity to attend an **intensive five-day workshop in Bangkok from August 1 to 5 with Berlin-based FashionTech house ELEKTROCOUTURE.**

The call for proposals is open to all students and young professionals of Southeast Asian, Australian and New Zealand nationality between the ages of 20 to 35. Eligible participants are residents of Australia, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, New Zealand, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand or Vietnam.
