Information for Students

Applicants from the United States with a High School Diploma can either apply for a course in preliminary studies at a **STUDIENKOLLEG** (preparatory college) in Germany, or, they can begin studying at a college or university in the US and then be admitted to a course in the same subject in Germany.

Academic Requirements

- High School Diploma: general admission to a preparatory course at a Studienkolleg.
- SAT 1300 points+ / ACT 29 points+ and CumGPA of 3.0: direct application in any subject area.
- AP tests in certain subjects:
- English or 1 further foreign language
- 1 mathematical/natural science subject
- 1 further subject (e.g. European History, etc.)

Language Requirements

- B1: Level Certification: qualifies for admission to a Studienkolleg: studienkollegs.de/home.html
- B2 and/or C1 Level Certification: qualifies for admission to some universities
- C2 and/or TestDaF Level Certification: qualifies for admission to all universities
