Wiki Gender is a collaborative knowledge platform which is constantly collecting and producing material on gender and women-related issues in Arabic. It provides open content and promotes the production of knowledge in this field by all those interested in these topics.

After a year of brainstorming and extensive work between Goethe Institute and the Arab Digital Expression Foundation (ADEF) in collaboration with gender and women's rights organizations and individuals researching similar topics, Wiki Gender launches on December 2016 to start a journey of archiving, assimilating and documenting information on gender and women's issues whether academic, artistic, or media-related.

Wiki Gender aims at

- Building a cumulative knowledge base on gender- and women's issues in Arabic through collaborative volunteer work
- Monitoring and documenting of activities, groups, initiatives, projects and organizations related to the topics of interest

- Coalescing the exchange of experiences between individuals, groups or organizations interested in gender- and women-related topics
- Encouraging and motivating the participation involvement in the project whether through the Wiki or other platforms

The Wiki Gender consists of voluntary members, and it is open to anybody interested in becoming part of the project. You are welcome to attend the meeting sessions and the public discussions to work on improving the content of the Wiki in a more participatory way.
