Exam organization and procedures

Please bring the following documents with you:

- Photo ID (official ID card or passport)
- Ballpoint pen (blue or black)
- Receipt for the exam fee
- Food and drink

In the morning

The written group exams Goethe Zertifikat A1/SD1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2 start at 9.00 am. Please arrive approx. 30 minutes before the start of your exam.

The entrance is in Diesterwegstrasse 34 and Kaulbachstr. 1 (lift).

Goethe-Zertifikat SD1/A1 and A2: The oral exams will take place after the written exam.

You will receive the information on the exact times of the oral exams on the morning of the written examination. The exams can take until approximately 2.00 pm.

You will receive the results two days after the examination at our Consultation and Advice Office in Diesterwegplatz 72.

Goethe-Zertifikat B1, B2, C1, C2:

The written exams will end at around 1.00 pm.

In the afternoon:

The oral exams will begin at approximately 1.30 pm. They may continue until 6.00 pm. You will be given your exact time for the oral exam in the second break after the listening section.

You can receive the results of these exams two weeks after the examination at our Consultation and Advice Office in Diesterwegplatz 72.

Please note that delays are possible in the exam schedule. There are breaks between the sections of the examination.
